The following issues were identified as significant and were addressed by WSMV-TV to serve the community and act in the public interest as set forth by the Federal Communications Commission.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT – includes efforts to enhance the community and promote increased pride, such as fundraising for various programs, revitalizing neighborhoods, volunteerism, etc.

CRIME & LAW ENFORCEMENT - includes crime prevention, court proceedings, police conduct, fire safety, etc.

SOCIAL SERVICES – includes stories that reflect services provided to the community, i.e. child support, counseling, policy development, advocacy, teaching, community organizing, etc.

HEALTHCARE – includes health education and awareness, healthcare for the elderly, wellness, and fitness environmental issues, etc.

SAFETY – Safety in the community; construction, bridges, road conditions, etc.

ECONOMY – includes local issues, job opportunities, and the state of the economy, etc.

EDUCATION – includes education standards, school safety, efforts to keep up with growth in the area, budget matters, etc.

GOVERNMENT – includes federal, state, local and county political issues / events, profiles and headlines regarding political leaders and newsmakers, governmental corruption, etc.

ENVIRONMENT – includes stories where the environment has affected the community and/or surrounding areas, etc.

INVESTIGATIVE – includes in-depth stories of viewer issues and concerns, legal regulations, state legislation (as it affects the communities), security, etc.

The listed programs aired on the station during the reporting period on the dates and times indicated. Each program regularly provides information or addresses current issues of concern to viewers in the area where the station is located.

CHIME Issues – Airdate 4/7/23 5:14 PM- 5:17 PM

A Tennessee woman says she doesn't know how she'll pay her bills after her account was frozen over a fraud concern. WSMV4 Investigates reveals issues with the neobank "CHIME" surrounding account freezes, and lets viewers know what they need to do should they also have issues with online banks.

Mesonet Legislation- Airdate 4/13/23- 6:06 PM- 6:09PM

Chief Investigative Reporter Jeremy Finley reveals legislation for a mesonet system that would help alert the community ahead of flooding and severe weather. It's a system many states have, but Tennessee does not.

Investigative reporter Stacey Cameron reveals a convoluted tracking system for safety drills in public schools. There is no standardized tracking, nor is it posted publicly for review. Parents concerned about whether safety drills are completed would need to ask their child's school.

Our reporting led to his indictment for falsifying documents in connection to the investigation. This month, he was found guilty.

Blurred Line – Imposter Cops Airdate 4/27/23 6:02 PM- 6:07 PM

WSMV4 Investigates reveals how people who are not certified police officers in the state of Tennessee are working security while wearing the word “police” on their shirts and patches. Legal experts raise questions about public safety and the legality of the verbiage used on their outfits.

Piedmont Gas Meter Issue – Airdate 4/28 6:35 PM- 6:38 PM

An East Nashville homeowner turns to WSMV4 Investigates after his bill skyrockets. Investigative Reporter Stacey Cameron went to Piedmont Natural Gas for answers and offered viewers tips on what to do if they suspect a malfunctioning meter is leading to high bills.

Solaren Former Employees Talk Airdate 5/3/23 6:01PM- 6:06PM

Two former employees of Solaren say the company allows people who are not certified officer to wear police identification. They say it causes a safety issue. The company was highlighted by WSMV4 Investigates after finding that very same issue happening in popular tourist areas of Nashville.

A woman is warning people in Middle Tennessee against purchasing a puppy from an area kennel, after she says the dog, she purchased had a life-threatening illness.

A South Nashville man says what started as a neighborhood nuisance with a dilapidated road has gotten so bad, taxpayer dollars may be needed to fix it. He, and his council person, want the city to step in.
