

## **ITEMS OF PUBLIC INTEREST AIRED ON KDPM-FM (Q4 2022)**

As part of KDPM's *regular programming schedule* from 6a-7p Monday through Friday the station airs announcements, updates, interviews regarding a myriad of items in the public interest. It should be noted that these announcements are not relegated to only 30 minutes of "public interest" programming per week but are integrated as part of the station's day-to-day programming with each of the announcements airing a minimum of three to four times a day and sometimes more. The following is a list of some, but not limited to, the topics and events that aired during the fourth quarter of 2022

During each broadcast of Hallsville ISD sports between October 7 and December 30 the station air two five-minute interviews featuring on of the school's administrators and one of the school's leading students to discuss activities and concerns related to the school.

Every Tuesday from October 3-December 31 the station aired a weekly Covid-19 update from the Harrison County Judge that tracks news about the virus

First Wednesday of each month the station airs an interview with the Marshall Chamber of Activities about its activities

October 1-October 15 the station aired announcements about the Texas Sounds International Music Competition presented by the non-profit East Texas Performing Arts

October 1-December 16 the station aired announcements about "Boogie on the Bricks" a free downtown music events open to the public

October 1-October 29 the station aired announcements about an appearance by musician Dale Watson who appeared at the City of Marshall's non-profit Memorial City Hall

October 1-October 8 the station aired announcements about the Marshall Chamber of Commerce's Fire Ant Festival...a fundraising event for the chamber... and the City of Jefferson's Burn Run which raises money for burn victims. A live broadcasts aired on October 8 for both events

October 10-October 29 the station aired announcements promoting the non-profit Child Advocacy Support Association's "Trick or Trunk" event that raises money for the organization

October 10-October 14 the station aired announcements promoting the non-profit Marshall Regional Arts Council's Third Saturday Arts Festival

**Tuesday October 18-December 16 the station aired announcements about “Shop With a Cop,” an event wherein economically-challenged kids received donated gift cards to shop with a local law enforcement agent to use for shopping for the child’s family for Christmas**
