## ITEMS OF PUBLIC INTEREST AIRED ON KDPM-FM (Q3 2022)

As part of KDPM's regular programming schedule from 6a-7p the station airs announcements, updates and interviews regarding a myriad of items in the public interest. It should be noted that these announcements are not relegated to only 30 minutes of "public interest programming" per week but are integrated as part of the station's day-to-day programming with each of the announcements airing a minimum of three to four times a day and sometimes more. The following is a list of some, but not limited to, the topics and events that aired during the third quarter of 2022Z:

During each broadcast of Hallsville ISD sports between August 26 and September 30 the station aired two five-minute interviews featuring one of the school's administrators and one of the school's selected leading students to discuss activities and concerns related to the school.

July 1-September: Announcements promoting events for non-profit events at the City of Marshall's Memorial City Hall, the Marshall Regional Arts Council and various non-profit fundraisers at Bear Creek Smokehouse

August 8-September 30: Announcements promoting the non-profit Texas Sounds International Music Awards Festival
