**DESCRIPTION:** KENNEWICK, WASH. - A FEW CHANGES CAN BE EXPECTED FOR AN ANNUAL FOURTH OF JULY CELEBRATION AT COLUMBIA PARK IN KENNEWICK. LEADERS SAID THE HAPO RIVER OF FIRE IS GOING TO INCLUDE NEW EVENTS FOR VISITORS. THIS WILL BE THE FIRST YEAR THE TRICITY WATER FOLLIES IS MANAGING THE POPULAR EVENT, FORMERLY MANAGED BY THE TRI-CITIES REGIONAL CHAMBER OF COMMERCE. "WE WERE LOOKING AROUND TO SEE WHAT WE COULD DO. IT WAS KIND OF SHORT NOTICE FOR US TO GET OUR PLANNING GOING," SAID TRI-CITY WATER FOLLIES EVENT DIRECTOR KATHY POWELL. "BUT WE COULD PUT IN A BEER GARDEN THIS YEAR, SO THERE WILL BE SOME ADULT BEVERAGES DOWN THERE." THE PARK WILL OPEN FOR PARKING AT 9 A.M., WEDNESDAY. A DONATION OF \$5 PER CAR IS REQUESTED TO HELP THE NON-PROFIT TRI-CITY WATER FOLLIES ASSOCIATION COVER EXPENSE. FOLKS CAN ENJOY FOOD, KID-FRIENDLY ACTIVITIES, LIVE MUSIC AND A BEER GARDEN. THE NIGHT WILL THEN LIGHT UP AROUND 10 P.M. WITH WHAT ORGANIZERS ARE CALLING AN EXPANDED FIREWORKS EXTRAVAGANZA. "BIGGER, BOLDER, BRIGHTER TRULY EPITOMIZES THIS YEARS' EXPERIENCE!" SAID POWELL. THIS YEAR, FIREWORKS WILL BE SET OFF FROM THE GROUND AT THE NEIL F LAMPSON PIT AREA, INSTEAD OF A BARGE IN THE COLUMBIA RIVER USED FOR PREVIOUS CELEBRATIONS AFTER THE BARGE WAS DEEMED UNSAFE. THIS WILL TAKE UP SOME SPACE THAT WAS ORIGINALLY USED FOR GENERAL ADMISSION. THE FIREWORKS NEED 1,000 FEET CLEARANCE ON EACH SIDE OF WHERE THEY WILL BE LIT OFF. POWELL IS ENCOURAGING FOLKS TO GET TO THE EVENT EARLY TO FIND A GOOD SPOT TO PARK AND TO WATCH THE FIREWORKS SHOW.

LOS LÍDERES DIJERON QUE EL HAPO RIVER OF FIRE INCLUIRÁ NUEVOS EVENTOS PARA LOS VISITANTES. ESTE SERÁ EL PRIMER AÑO QUE TRICITY WATER FOLLIES ADMINISTRARÁ EL POPULAR EVENTO, ANTERIORMENTE ADMINISTRADO POR LA CÁMARA DE COMERCIO REGIONAL DE TRI-CITIES. "ESTÁBAMOS MIRANDO A NUESTRO ALREDEDOR PARA VER QUÉ PODÍAMOS HACER. FALTABA POCO TIEMPO PARA QUE PUDIÉRAMOS PONER EN MARCHA NUESTRA PLANIFICACIÓN", DIJO LA DIRECTORA DEL EVENTO TRI-CITY WATER FOLLIES, KATHY POWELL. "PERO PUDIMOS PONER EN UNA CERVECERÍA AL AIRE AÑO, ENTONCES HABRÁ ALGUNAS BEBIDAS PARA ADULTOS ALLÍ ". EL PARQUE SE ABRIRÁ PARA EL ESTACIONAMIENTO A LAS 9 A.M., EL MIÉRCOLES. SE SOLICITA UNA DONACIÓN DE \$ 5 POR AUTOMÓVIL PARA AYUDAR A LA ASOCIACIÓN TRI-CITY WATER FOLLIES SIN FINES DE LUCRO A CUBRIR LOS GASTOS. LA GENTE PUEDE DISFRUTAR DE COMIDA, ACTIVIDADES PARA NIÑOS, MÚSICA EN VIVO Y UNA CERVECERÍA AL AIRE LIBRE. LA NOCHE SE ILUMINARÁ ALREDEDOR DE LAS 10 P.M. ESTE AÑO, LOS FUEGOS ARTIFICIALES SE DESPLEGARÁN DESDE EL SUELO EN EL ÁREA DE BOXES DE NEIL F LAMPSON, EN LUGAR DE UNA BARCAZA EN EL RÍO COLUMBIA UTILIZADA PARA CELEBRACIONES PREVIAS DESPUÉS DE QUE LA BARCAZA SE CONSIDERARA INSEGURA. ESTO OCUPARÁ UN ESPACIO QUE ORIGINALMENTE SE UTILIZÓ PARA LA ADMISIÓN GENERAL. LOS FUEGOS ARTIFICIALES NECESITAN 1.000 PIES DE ESPACIO LIBRE EN CADA LADO DE DONDE SERÁN ENCENDIDOS. POWELL ANIMA A LA GENTE A LLEGAR TEMPRANO AL EVENTO PARA ENCONTRAR UN BUEN LUGAR PARA ESTACIONAR Y PARA VER EL ESPECTÁCULO DE FUEGOS ARTIFICIALES.

**DESCRIPTION:** WEST RICHLAND, WASH. — YOU CAN'T START A FIRE WITHOUT A SPARK AND THERE WILL BE PLENTY OF THOSE WEDNESDAY WITH MANY PEOPLE SETTING OFF FIREWORKS FOR THE FOURTH OF JULY. MUCH OF THE GRASS IN BENTON AND FRANKLIN COUNTIES IS DRY AND BROWN AND AS BENTON COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT 4 CAPT. TOM HARPER PUT IT, READY TO GO UP IN FLAMES. "THEY SAY STRUCTURES FIRES CAN DOUBLE IN SIZE EVERY MINUTE AND IT SEEMS LIKE WILDLAND FIRES GO EVEN FASTER." NOW THERE'S ANOTHER REASON TO BE ON GUARD. THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE UPGRADED A FIRE WEATHER WATCH ISSUED FOR THE HOLIDAY TO A RED FLAG WARNING. ANY FIRES THAT START WILL LIKELY SPREAD RAPIDLY THANKS TO LOW HUMIDITY AND GUSTY WINDS AND IT ONLY TAKES A SECOND FOR A STRAY SPARK FROM A FIREWORK TO CAUSE A LOT OF DESTRUCTION. "EVERYTHING IS GOING TO BE LIKE A PERFECT STORM OF JUST FIRE WEATHER, SO HOPEFULLY PEOPLE ARE SAFE AND RESPONSIBLE," SAYS CAPT. HARPER. HE ASKS EVERYONE TO BE RESPONSIBLE WHILE LIGHTING FIREWORKS, MAKING SURE TO KEEP WATER NEARBY AND FOLLOW SAFETY PRECAUTIONS AND LAWS. HOWEVER, IF IT GETS WINDY, HE ASKS PEOPLE NOT TO LIGHT OFF ANY OF THEIR FIREWORKS. INSTEAD SAVE THEM FOR A SAFER TIME. AS FOR BCFD 4, WORKING INDEPENDENCE DAY IS A DAY THEY'RE PREPARED FOR. "ALL OF OUR CAREER STAFF AND VOLUNTEERS ARE INVITED INTO THE STATION, SO WE'LL HAVE HOPEFULLY 20 TO 30 PEOPLE HERE STANDING BY. SO, IT SHOULDN'T BE A PROBLEM GETTING TRUCKS OUT ON THE ROAD AND JUST HOPE IT'S NOT ONE OF THOSE NIGHTS THAT WE GO FROM FIRE TO FIRE TO FIRE." THIS RED FLAG WARNING RUNS WEDNESDAY FROM 1 TO 10 P.M. FOR PORTIONS OF EASTERN WASHINGTON AND OREGON.

GRAN PARTE DE LA HIERBA EN LOS CONDADOS DE BENTON Y FRANKLIN ES SECA Y MARRÓN Y COMO LO DIJO EL CAPITÁN TOM HARPER DEL DISTRITO DE BOMBEROS DEL CONDADO DE BENTON 4, LISTO PARA ESTALLAR EN LLAMAS. "DICEN QUE LOS INCENDIOS DE ESTRUCTURAS PUEDEN DUPLICARSE EN TAMAÑO CADA MINUTO Y PARECE QUE LOS INCENDIOS FORESTALES VAN INCLUSO MÁS RÁPIDO". AHORA HAY OTRA RAZÓN PARA ESTAR EN GUARDIA. EL SERVICIO METEOROLÓGICO NACIONAL ACTUALIZÓ UNA ALERTA METEOROLÓGICA DE INCENDIOS EMITIDA PARA LAS VACACIONES A UNA ADVERTENCIA DE BANDERA ROJA. PIDE A TODOS SER RESPONSABLES MIENTRAS ENCIENDEN FUEGOS ARTIFICIALES, ASEGURÁNDOSE DE MANTENER EL AGUA CERCA Y SEGUIR LAS PRECAUCIONES DE SEGURIDAD Y SIN EMBARGO, SI HACE VIENTO, LE PIDE A LA GENTE QUE NO ENCIENDA NINGUNO DE SUS FUEGOS ARTIFICIALES, SINO QUE LOS SALVE POR UN TIEMPO MÁS SEGURO. EN CUANTO A BCFD 4, TRABAJAR EN EL DÍA DE LA INDEPENDENCIA ES UN DÍA PARA EL QUE ESTÁN PREPARADOS ". EL PERSONAL DE CARRERA Y LOS VOLUNTARIOS ESTÁN INVITADOS A LA ESTACIÓN, ASÍ QUE ESPERAMOS TENER ENTRE 20 Y 30 PERSONAS AQUÍ. ASÍ QUE NO DEBERÍA SER UN PROBLEMA SACAR CAMIONES EN EL CAMINO Y SOLO ESPERO QUE

NO SEA UNA DE ESAS NOCHES EN QUE VAYAMOS DE FUEGO EN FUEGO AL FUEGO ". ESTA ADVERTENCIA DE BANDERA ROJA SE REALIZA EL MIÉRCOLES DE 1 A 10 PM PARA PARTES DEL ESTE DE WASHINGTON. Y OREGON.

**DESCRIPTION:** YAKIMA, WASH.- WE MAY WORRY ABOUT OUR PARENTS OR GRANDPARENTS AS THEY START TO GET OLDER. A RECENT STUDY FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL AND HEALTH SERVICES (DSHS) SHOWS WE MAY HAVE TO KEEP AN EVEN CLOSER EYE ON THEM. IN 2012, THEY HAD AROUND 19,000 CASES OF ADULT ABUSE IN WASHINGTON BUT THAT NUMBER HAS GREATLY INCREASED IN THE LAST FIVE YEARS. IN 2017, THE NUMBER OF CASES ROSE TO ALMOST 50,000. WHICH IS MORE THAN TWO AND A HALF TIMES AS MUCH. "TO HAVE THE NUMBERS CONTINUE TO GO LIKE THIS YEAR AFTER YEAR IS CERTAINLY CONCERNING FOR US AND SHOULD BE CONCERNING FOR EVERYONE," DSHS SPOKESPERSON CHRIS WRIGHT SAID. PEOPLE USUALLY OVER THE AGE OF 60 OR THOSE WITH DISABILITIES CAN BE AFFECTED BY ADULT ABUSE, BUT THAT DOESN'T MEAN THEY'RE ALL SEEING SOME SORT OF PHYSICAL VIOLENCE. DSHS SAID MORE AND MORE CASES ARE ABOUT TAKING ADVANTAGE OF THEIR MONEY. "LAST YEAR, OVER 10,000 INVESTIGATIONS SO IT'S MAKING UP ALMOST A FOURTH OF TOTAL INVESTIGATIONS FOR ABUSE," WRIGHT SAID. A GROUP IN YAKIMA CALLED AGING AND LONG-TERM CARE (ALTC) TRIES TO HELP AND PROTECT PEOPLE FROM THESE TYPES OF ABUSE AS THEY GET OLDER BY CONNECTING THEM WITH LOCAL RESOURCES. SUCH AS A HOMECARE GIVER OR AN ATTORNEY. CORRIE BLYTHE WITH ALTC SAID DESIGNATING SOMEONE AS YOUR DECISION MAKER IN CASE SOMETHING HAPPENS TO YOU IS AN EASY STEP TO PROTECT YOUR FUTURE, BUT BE SURE TO GET IT IN WRITING. THAT PERSON COULD BE A FAMILY MEMBER OR FRIEND, BUT THE KEY IS TO LET THAT PERSON KNOW WHAT'S IMPORTANT TO YOU GOING FORWARD. "IT ONLY TAKES ONE LIFE CRISIS TO PUT US AT RISK. SO, INDIVIDUALS WITH ANY KIND OF VULNERABILITY LIKE A MEDICAL ISSUE OR A PHYSICAL ISSUE HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY FOR OTHER INDIVIDUALS OR SITUATIONS TO COMPROMISE THEM," BLYTHE SAID. YOU CAN ALSO BE THE ONE TO HELP SOMEONE THAT MAY BE FACING SOME SORT OF ADULT ABUSE. BLYTHE SAID PAY ATTENTION TO ANY CHANGES YOU MIGHT SEE IN A PERSON AND DON'T BE AFRAID TO LET THEM KNOW WHAT YOU SEE. "SHARE IT WITH THE PERSON AS WELL. 'I'M CONCERNED ABOUT YOU. DO YOU MIND IF I GET A HOLD OF THE AGING AND DISABILITY RESOURCES CENTER AND JUST HAVE THEM GIVE YOU A CALL?' THAT'S A GOOD WAY TO DO IT," SHE SAID. **DESCRIPTION:** WAPATO, WASH. – “HE NEEDS TO BE HELD ACCOUNTABLE,” SAID WAPATO MAYOR JUAN OROZCO. OROZCO REVEALS TO ACTION NEWS THAT THERE WAS PLENTY OF THINGS GOING ON AT CITY HALL THAT SHOULDN’T HAVE BEEN, PRIOR TO HIM TAKING OFFICE. “WHEN I WAS ELECTED, I SAT DOWN AT THE COMPUTER, AFTER BEING SWORN IN. TURNED IT ON. AND IT WAS RIGHT THERE,” SAID OROZCO. HE’S TALKING ABOUT A FACEBOOK ACCOUNT HE SAYS BELONGS TO FORMER-MAYOR TONY GUZMAN. WHILE THERE WAS NO PROFILE PICTURE ASSOCIATED WITH ACCOUNT, OROZCO SAYS HE HIRED AN IT PROFESSIONAL, AND THEY COULD DETERMINE THE FACEBOOK ACCOUNT WAS CREATED ON A CITY COMPUTER, WITH THE CITY-ISSUED MAYOR EMAIL ADDRESS AND A CITY CELL PHONE, LINKED TO IT. I OBTAINED HUNDREDS OF PAGES OF FACEBOOK MESSAGES, AND IN THEM, I CAME ACROSS SOME CONVERSATIONS THAT APPEAR GRAPHIC AND QUESTIONABLE. “IT APPEARS THAT TONY NEGOTIATED WITH A CITIZEN TO PRODUCE A DOCUMENT THAT WOULD IMPLY THAT AN INDIVIDUAL DID COMMUNITY HOURS THAT WERE NOT DONE FOR THE COURT,” SAID OROZCO. IN THESE MESSAGES FROM 2017, A WOMAN ASKS THE ACCOUNT TO FORGE COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS, AND IN RETURN SHE OFFERS PAYMENT. THE ACCOUNT AGREES AND SAYS, ‘OK, I CAN SAY SHE PUT IN HER HOURS AT THE FOOD BANK,’ AND, ‘IF YOU CAN STOP BY MY OFFICE, I ACTUALLY DO IT ON CITY OF WAPATO LETTERHEAD.’ IN SPANISH, SHE SAYS, ‘YOU JUST TELL ME HOW MUCH IT IS, AND I’LL PASS BY YOUR HOME TO PAY YOU.’ BUT, GUZMAN SAYS THESE CONVERSATIONS NEVER HAPPENED. “I KNOW WHAT YOU’RE TALKING ABOUT, BUT IT HAS NOTHING TO DO WITH COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS. SHE WAS INQUIRING ABOUT A MARRIAGE DISSOLUTION, AND I WAS TELLING HER WHAT SHE NEEDED TO DO, AS FAR AS GOING TO THE COURTHOUSE,” SAID GUZMAN. IN OTHER MESSAGES, IT APPEARS THAT THINGS LIKE PORNOGRAPHIC VIDEOS WERE VIEWED AND SENT, AND MESSAGES WERE ALSO EXCHANGED BETWEEN THE ACCOUNT HOLDER AND AN EX CITY COUNCILWOMAN, TALKING ABOUT THE CURRENT COUNCILWOMAN WHO BEAT HER IN THE PAST ELECTION. “HE STARTS IN, TALKING ABOUT ME, CALLING ME A HO AND SAYING I LOOK LIKE A COW IN A DRESS, ON ALL FOURS, READY TO GET, YOU KNOW, ABUSED, FOR LACK OF A BETTER WORD,” SAID COUNCILWOMAN DORA ALVAREZ-ROA. ALVAREZ-ROA SAYS SHE IS CONTEMPLATING SUING THE CITY FOR DEFAMATION, FOR FAILING TO HOLD THE THEN-MAYOR ACCOUNTABLE. BECAUSE OF ALL THESE ALLEGED ACTS OF OFFICIAL MISCONDUCT, WAPATO CITY ATTORNEY ROBERT NOE SENT A LETTER TO GUZMAN, REQUESTING THAT THEY MEET. IN THE LETTER, THE CITY ACCUSES GUZMAN OF THINGS INCLUDING BRIBERY, ABUSE OF OFFICE, AND VIEWING AND SENDING PORNOGRAPHY. BUT, GUZMAN SAYS HE HAS NO INTENTION OF MEETING WITH NOE OR THE CITY BECAUSE THERE IS NO MERIT TO THE ALLEGATIONS. GUZMAN HAS FILED A RESTRAINING ORDER AGAINST OROZCO, SAYING THE CURRENT MAYOR HAS BEEN HARASSING HIM, DRIVING PAST HIS HOUSE, CURSING AT HIM, AND THAT HE’S SCARED. “THEY’RE JUST ACCUSATIONS AND LIKE I SAID, THEY WANT ME OUT IS BASICALLY WHAT THEY WANT. THEY WANT ME OFF THE COUNCIL, AND SO THEY’RE PROBABLY GONNA USE ALL THAT,” SAID

GUZMAN. AS OF LAST WEEK, OROZCO SAID GUZMAN WAS NO LONGER A COUNCIL MEMBER, BUT GUZMAN SAYS HE'S UNSURE OF WHERE HE STANDS ON COUNCIL. AND NOW WITH GUZMAN'S RESTRAINING ORDER AGAINST OROZCO, MEETING WITH THE CITY ISN'T CURRENTLY AN OPTION.

EL DICE QUE LA PAGINA ESTABA ABIERTA Y MIRO MENSAJES INAPROPIADOS ENTRE EL EX ALCALDE TONY GUZMAN CON OTRAS PERSONAS. LOS VIO Y UN DE ELLOS PARECIA QUE LE PIDE QUE HAGA UN DOCUMENTO CON HORAS DE SERVICIO COMUNITARIO -- A CAMBIO DE DINERO. Y LA CUENTA -- QUE SUPUESTAMENTE ES DE GUZMAN LUEGO ACEPTO. HABLAMOS CON GUZMAN Y NOS DIJO QUE SI SABE DE LOS QUE ESTABAMOS HABLANDO -- PERO QUE NO TENIA NADA QUE VER CON HORAS COMUNITARIAS ---- Y QUE SOLO LE ESTABA AYUDANDO CON DOCUMENTOS DE MATRIMONIO. AL MOMENTO GUZMAN PUSO UNA ORDEN DE RESTRICION EN CONTRA DE JUAN OROZCO PORQUE DICE QUE LO HA ESTADO MOLESTANDO Y PASANDO POR SU CASA Y QUE TIENE MIEDO. PEOPLE LIKE LEAHA SCRIBNER, A YAKIMA LOCAL WHO FINISHED SERVING HER TIME AT THE YAKIMA COUNTY JAIL. STILL AFTER MONTHS ON THE JOB HUNT, SHE REMAINS UNEMPLOYED AND EAGER TO WORK. THE ONLY DIFFERENCE WITH THE NEW LAW NOW SHE SAYS, IS BEING DENIED DURING THE INTERVIEW PROCESS RATHER THAN NOT GETTING A CALL AT ALL. "SO, WHAT'S THE USE OF HAVING THE "BAN THE BOX" IF THEY'RE STILL RUNNING BACKGROUND CHECKS AND GETTING DISCRIMINATED ANYWAYS? WHY DO WE NOT GET THE OPPORTUNITY TO NOT MAKE OURSELVES BETTER, EVEN THOUGH WE DID OUR TIME WE ARE STILL GETTING JUDGED," SAID SCRIBNER. A STATEWIDE RE-ENTRY OPERATOR FOR WORKFORCE SOLUTIONS JAMES WALKER WORKS CLOSELY WITH PEOPLE WHO NEED JOBS INCLUDING EX-FELONS. HE SAYS THIS NEW LAW WILL GIVE EX-FELONS A CHANCE TO BE SEEN FIRST AS A PERSON AND NOT A CRIMINAL, AND SEE'S THIS MOTIVATING MORE EX-FELONS TO APPLY FOR JOBS. "I THINK FROM A MOTIVATIONAL STANDPOINT, THERE ARE ALREADY FACING SIGNIFICANT CHALLENGES. SO IT IS A DOOR OPENER FROM THAT STANDPOINT AND MOTIVATION FOR PEOPLE WHO WANT TO HAVE A NEW START," SAID WALKER. THE LAW EXCLUDES JOBS IN LAW ENFORCEMENT, STATE AGENCIES, SCHOOLS AND OTHER JOBS THAT INVOLVE CHILDREN, DISABLED OR VULNERABLE ADULTS. SCRIBNER SAYS THIS IS A STEP IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION, BUT SAYS THERE NEEDS TO BE MORE PROGRAMS AND HELP CENTERS AVAILABLE IN YAKIMA FOR FELONS TO GET A BETTER SHOT AT SECURING THE JOB. "PEOPLE MESS UP, THEY TAKE THINGS FOR GRANTED, BUT NOT EVERYBODY DOES THAT. I'VE DONE MY TIME, BUT NOW I'M TRYING TO BE A PRODUCTIVE MEMBER OF SOCIETY," SAID SCRIBNER.

WHEN POLICE ARRIVED, THEY SAY SHOEMAKER WAS ALIVE, BUT SOON SUFFERED FROM A HEART ATTACK THAT KILLED HIM. NOW, YAKIMA COUNTY CORONER JACK HAWKINS SAYS IT WAS THE ASSAULT THAT CAUSED IT. "WE FOUND OUT THAT HE DOES HAVE A BAD HEART, BUT HE WAS ASSAULTED, AND THE ADRENALINE FROM THAT ASSAULT MORE THAN LIKELY CAUSED THE HEART ATTACK," SAID HAWKINS. ROGERS WAS INITIALLY FACING CHARGES OF ASSAULT, BUT NOW BOTH ROGERS AND CALLAHAN FACE SECOND-DEGREE MURDER CHARGES.

AHORA, EL FORENSE DEL CONDADO DE YAKIMA, JACK HAWKINS DICE QUE FUE EL ASALTO QUE LO CAUSÓ. HOWEVER, EDUCATORS IN TOPPENISH SAID THE DISTRICT IS ONLY OFFERING THEM AN EIGHT PERCENT RAISE, LEAVING TOO MUCH ON THE TABLE. LEAD BARGAINER TERRI WINCKLER SAID THAT IS ABOUT AN EXTRA \$34 PER PAYCHECK. "WE DO IT FOR THE KIDS BUT WE ALSO ARE HERE TO MAKE A LIVING, AND THE COST OF LIVING IS GOING UP," WINCKLER SAID. WINCKLER SAID THE 230 TEACHERS THAT MAKE UP THE TOPPENISH SCHOOL DISTRICT ARE ASKING FOR THEIR FAIR SHARE. SHE SAID SOME TEACHERS ARE FORCED TO GET SECOND AND THIRD JOBS JUST TO MAKE ENDS MEET. TEACHERS PRESENTED THE SCHOOL DISTRICT WITH A LETTER ON MONDAY ASKING FOR A MORE REASONABLE INCREASE. MCLAUGHLIN IS A PART OF THE GROUP AND SAID HE CHOSE TO BECOME A MIDDLE SCHOOL TEACHER IN TOPPENISH BECAUSE IT'S HIS COMMUNITY AND HE WANTS TO SEE IT THRIVE. "YOU DO THIS 'CAUSE YOU LOVE KIDS," HE SAID. "YOU DO IT BECAUSE YOU LOVE YOUR COMMUNITY AND WANT THEM TO BE STRONGER AND MORE CAPABLE. BUT WE DESERVE TO BE COMPENSATED LIKE ANYONE ELSE FOR THAT WORK." THE TOPPENISH TEACHERS SAID THEY HAVE ONE YEAR LEFT IN THEIR THREE-YEAR CONTRACT AND HAVE A NO STRIKE CLAUSE, SO THEY HOPE TO COME TO AN AGREEMENT. KIMA ACTION NEWS REACHED OUT TO THE TOPPENISH SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR A COMMENT AND HAS YET TO HEAR BACK FROM THEM.

JEAN MENDOZA. MENDOZA SAYS ONE OF THE LEADING CAUSES OF THE POLLUTED GROUNDWATER IN OUR AREA STEMS FROM THE LARGE PRODUCTION OF DAIRY FARMS. "WE HAVE 35 PERCENT OF WASHINGTON STATE'S DAIRY COWS. THIS IS THE EQUIVALENT OF A CITY HAVING 2.5 MILLION PEOPLE WITH NO SEWAGE SERVICES. VERY OFTEN THE NITRATES FROM THE ANIMAL WASTE IS FLUSHED DOWN INTO THE AQUIFERS, SO WE HAVE SOME VERY HIGH LEVELS OF NITRATES IN THE LOWER YAKIMA VALLEY," SAID MENDOZA. THE GROUNDWATER ADVISORY COMMITTEE HAS BEEN WORKING ON A PLAN TO ADDRESS GROUNDWATER AND NITRATES FOR THE LAST SIX YEARS. SOME ON THE GROUNDWATER ADVISORY COMMITTEE SAY THE PLAN WILL DO NOTHING BUT FAIL THE LOWER VALLEY COMMUNITY. FRIENDS OF TOPPENISH CREEK RELEASED A REPORT LAYING OUT WHY THEY SAY PLAN WON'T WORK. MENDOZA SAYS THERE NEEDS TO BE AT LEAST 30 MONITORING STATIONS TO TEST THE NUMBER OF WELLS NEEDED IN THE LOWER VALLEY. YAKIMA COUNTY SAYS THEY HAVE TO GET APPROVAL TO MONITOR EACH WELL AND IT'S TAKEN MORE TIME THAN EXPECTED, BUT THEY SAY THEY PLAN ON HAVING MORE INSTALLED WHEN MORE WELLS ARE APPROVED. NEWHOUSE SAID HE HATES TO SEE FARMERS GO AND HOPES NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE FARM BILL CAN CHANGE THAT PATH. "THEIR NUMBER ONE TARGET IS TO PREY AFTER ELDERLY PEOPLE, AND A LOT OF THESE FOLKS HAVE MONEY IN THE BANK, RETIREMENT THROUGH LIFE SAVINGS, AND THAT'S WHAT'S REALLY HEARTBREAKING, WHEN YOU SEE SOMEONE LOSE A BIG CHUNK, IF NOT ALL OF THEIR LIFE SAVINGS," SAID BASTINELLI. HE SAYS THE WOMAN EVENTUALLY CAUGHT ON THAT IT WAS A SCAM, AND SHE CONTACTED THEM, BUT WHEN IT COMES TO MONEY LOST THROUGH SCAMS, IT'S NEARLY IMPOSSIBLE TO RECOVER IT. "THERE'S VERY LITTLE WE COULD DO. A LOT OF THESE SCAMMERS ARE OUT OF THE COUNTRY. ONCE THEY GET THE MONEY, IT'S HARD TO TRACE," HE SAID. BASTINELLI WANTS PEOPLE TO KNOW THAT A HUGE INDICATOR THAT A CALLER MAY BE TRYING TO SCAM YOU, IS THAT THE CALL COMES OUT OF THE BLUE, WITHOUT YOU INITIATING IT. "IF YOU GET AN UNSOLICITED CALL FROM SOMEONE CLAIMING TO BE MICROSOFT, THE IRS, A SWEEPSTAKES, WHATEVER IT MAY BE, DON'T RESPOND, JUST HANG UP," HE SAID. FINANCIAL ADVISOR BRIAN RAFFERTY AGREES. HE SAYS THERE ARE MANY RED FLAGS TO LOOK OUT FOR. WHAT THEY DIDN'T EXPECT TO SEE WERE THE TWO 12-YEAR-OLDS THAT WERE IN THE CAR. "IT CAN HAPPEN. WE DON'T MAKE IT UP," SAID SGT. TERRY BOEHLER WITH WEST RICHLAND POLICE. IT WAS ONE LAST SUMMER HURRAH. POLICE SAY A

12-YEAR-OLD GOT THE KEYS TO HIS GRANDFATHER'S CAR, GOT A FRIEND, AND TOOK OFF A MILE OR TWO TO FLAT TOP PARK. "I CAN THINK OF A LOT WORSE PLACES THEY CAN BE DRIVING HONESTLY, SAID AREA RESIDENT KENNETH SMITH. POLICE SAY THEY SAW THE CAR MAKE A LEFT TURN INTO THE PARK AND DROVE OVER TO TELL THEM THE PARK WAS CLOSED. OFFICERS THEN MET TWO 12-YEAR-OLDS AND CALLED THEIR MOTHERS TO THE SCENE. "SIMPLY KNOWING YOUR KIDS, KEEPING TRACK OF YOUR KEYS AND WHEN THEY DO GET CURIOUS ABOUT CERTAIN THINGS MAKE IT A LITTLE MORE COMPLICATED FOR THEM TO GET IT," SAID SGT. BOEHLER. THE KIDS ARE NOW FACING CRIMINAL CHARGES FOR DRIVING WITHOUT IDENTIFICATION OR A LICENSE AND TAKING A VEHICLE WITHOUT PERMISSION. "TALK TO YOUR KIDS AND EXPLAIN THE CONSEQUENCES OF THINGS," SGT. BOEHLER SAID. "IF THEY GO OUT THERE AT 12 AND DRIVE, AND THE POLICE CATCH YOU IT'S GOING TO BRING ABOUT CRIMINAL ISSUES." POLICE SAY THERE ARE A FEW PREVENTATIVE MEASURES YOU CAN TAKE TO KEEP YOUR KIDS AND YOUR CAR SAFE. "IF YOUR KIDS ARE DISPLAYING SIGNS OF 'I WANT TO BE A PROBLEM, OR I WANT TO EXPAND, OR I WANT TO GROW, OR I WANT MORE RESPONSIBILITIES, WE EITHER MUST PROVIDE THAT RESOURCE OR THEY'RE GOING TO FIND IT THEMSELVES," SGT. BOEHLER SAID. BUT OFFICERS SAY THE RESPONSIBILITY IS ON YOU TO KEEP YOUR KEYS OUT OF REACH. "IF YOU'RE REALLY WORRIED ABOUT IT, LOCK YOUR STUFF UP," SGT. BOEHLER SAID. POLICE SAY THEY DIDN'T SEE ANY RECKLESS DRIVING, SO THE DRIVER MUST HAVE LEARNED DRIVING BASICS SOMEWHERE. "NOWADAYS I THINK KIDS FEEL LIKE THEY CAN DRIVE JUST BECAUSE THEY'VE BEEN DRIVING MARIO KART," SAID RESIDENT DONNA ANDREWS. "YOU KNOW CAN'T BE MUCH DIFFERENT THAN THE VIDEO GAME ALTHOUGH YOU USE MORE THAN YOUR THUMBS." THE INVESTIGATION IS STILL PENDING, SO THE TWO HAVEN'T BEEN FORMALLY CHARGED WITH ANYTHING YET. POLICE SAY PARENTS KNOWINGLY LETTING THEIR UNLICENSED KIDS DRIVE THEIR CAR IS A CRIMINAL OFFENSE, AND IF IT WERE TO END IN AN ACCIDENT, IT MOST LIKELY WOULD NOT BE COVERED BY INSURANCE.

"I EXPECT TO HAVE SOMETHING THAT'S CONSUMABLE, THAT WE CAN ACTUALLY USE," SHE SAID. "I CAN'T WASH MY CLOTHES IN IT, I HAVE TO GO TO SUNNYSIDE OR SOMEWHERE ELSE TO WASH MY CLOTHES BECAUSE THEY COME OUT SMELLING. I SHOULDN'T HAVE TO GO TO WORK SMELLING LIKE A SEWER." MABTON MAYOR LAURA VAZQUEZ SAID THE CITY HAD A PROBLEM WITH THEIR FILTRATION SYSTEM AND BUILT UP POCKETS OF METHANE GAS GOT INTO THE WATER, CAUSING THE SMELL. SHE SAID THE CITY IS FIXING THE PROBLEM BY FLUSHING OUT THE LINES. "IF THEY COME ACROSS BROWN WATER ALL THEY NEED TO DO IS GO INTO THEIR BATHROOM, GO INTO THEIR KITCHEN TURN ON THEIR WATER AND LET IT RUN A FEW MINUTES," VAZQUEZ SAID. VAZQUEZ SAID THEY DON'T HAVE A CITY EMPLOYEE WHO TESTS THE WATER AS OF RIGHT NOW, SO THEY USE A TEAM FROM SELAH WHO MONITORS ITS QUALITY. KIMA SPOKE WITH THE CITY OF SELAH. THEY SAY A TEAM TESTED THE WATER IN MABTON BACK IN JULY AS A FAVOR TO THE CITY AND GAVE MABTON CITY LEADERS RECOMMENDATIONS ON HOW TO IMPROVE ITS WATER. LAURENCE DINGLE IS THE OWNER OF INTELLIGENT FRUIT VISION, A COMPANY IN ENGLAND THAT DEVELOPED A SYSTEM WITH GROWERS TO MAKE PRODUCTION EASIER IN THE FIELDS. "THE SUPPORT THAT WE GOT FROM GROWERS HAS HELPED US DEVELOP THE WHOLE SOLUTION," DINGLE SAID. "IT'S NOT DEVELOPED BY SCIENTISTS, IT'S DEVELOPED BY GROWERS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE WAY THAT WE'RE WORKING." THIS IS THE ONLY AGRICULTURE FRUIT COUNTING AND SIZING SYSTEM AVAILABLE IN THE WORLD. DEVELOPERS SAY A SCANNER IS ATTACHED TO A UTV THAT GROWERS CAN DRIVE DOWN ORCHARD ROWS AND VIDEO IS TAKEN OF THE FRUIT TO COUNT HOW MANY APPLES AND DETERMINE THE SIZE. DINGLE SAID KNOWING THE SIZE OF THEIR FRUIT CAN MAXIMIZE A GROWERS' PROFIT. "IF YOU KNOW THE NUMBER OF FRUIT PER TREE THAN YOU GOT A GOOD IDEA ABOUT WHAT THE SIZE OF THE FRUIT IS GOING TO BE ON THE TREE AT THE END OF HARVEST," HE SAID. "THE RIGHT SIZE FRUIT IS WORTH TWO OR THREE TIMES WHAT THE WRONG SIZE FRUIT IS WORTH." WASHINGTON TRACTOR CROP ADVISER KARL WIRTH SAID THIS NEW TECHNOLOGY CAN HELP REDUCE THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE NEEDED TO WORK IN THE FIELDS. WIRTH SAID THE TECHNOLOGY COSTS AROUND \$80,000 BUT WILL PAY FOR ITSELF. WASHINGTON TRACTOR SAID THEY ARE HOPING TO HAVE 10 OF THESE MACHINES IN WASHINGTON FIELDS BY MARCH.

IT'S AN ISSUE THAT CITY COUNCILWOMAN DULCE GUTIERREZ SAYS CAN BE IMPROVED WHEN IT COMES TO THE WAY VICTIMS AND WITNESSES ARE INTERACTING WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT. "DOMESTIC VIOLENCE IS THE NUMBER ONE VIOLENT CRIME IN THE CITY OF YAKIMA. IT'S AN ALARMING ISSUE AND IT'S ONE THAT DOESN'T RECEIVE AS MUCH ATTENTION AS IT DESERVES," SAID GUTIERREZ. CITY COUNCIL HAS DISCUSSED HIRING A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE LIAISON, A PERSON THAT WOULD WORK CLOSELY WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT, ALL ORGANIZATIONS THAT WORK WITH DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, AND GUIDE VICTIMS THROUGHOUT THEIR COURT CASES. STATISTICS FROM THE YAKIMA POLICE DEPARTMENT REVEAL THAT WITHIN THE LAST FOUR YEARS, THE NUMBER OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CASES ARE SLOWLY DECREASING. BUT EVEN THOUGH THE NUMBER IS DROPPING, YAKIMA RATES ARE MORE THAN DOUBLE THE AVERAGE FOR OTHER CITIES ACROSS WASHINGTON. GUTIERREZ SAYS THE COUNTY HAS THREE OR MORE VICTIM ADVOCATES FOR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND THE CITY HAS NONE. "YAKIMA WOULD BE IN A MUCH BETTER PLACE WHEN DEALING WITH DOMESTIC VIOLENCE IF IT HAD ITS OWN IN-HOUSE RESOURCE. NOW IT DOESN'T, AND SO VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE UNDER THE MISDEMEANOR LEVEL OF CRIME ARE NOT PROVIDED THE RESOURCES IF THEY WOULD BE IF THEY WERE A VICTIM OF A FELONY," SAID GUTIERREZ. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AT YWCA CHERI KILTY SAYS ADDING ANOTHER PERSON TO WORK CLOSELY WITH DOMESTIC VIOLENCE VICTIMS IN OUR AREA WILL BE A HUGE GAIN FOR THE COMMUNITY. "IF WE ARE TEACHING OUR CHILDREN HOW TO SOLVE CONFLICTS, HOW TO COPE WITH THEIR OWN EMOTIONS IN A WAY THAT ESCALATES TO ABUSE THEN IT'S WORTH EVERY EFFORT TO TRY AND MAKE AND IMPACT IN THAT," SAID KILTY.

ACCORDING TO OFFICIALS, THE ARMED PERSON REFUSED TO FOLLOW OFFICER COMMANDS. WWPD SAYS THREE OFFICERS, ERIC EASTMAN, NATHANAEL SMALL AND KEVIN TOON, DISCHARGED THEIR FIREARMS IN RESPONSE TO A PERCEIVED THREAT THE MAN POSED. DESPITE OFFICERS AND PARAMEDICS IMMEDIATE EFFORTS TO TRY TO HELP, THE MAN DIED. AUTHORITIES IDENTIFIED THE DECEASED AS 40-YEAR-OLD CHRISTOPHER ADAM BORLAND, FROM WALLA WALLA. THE WSP SAYS THEY'VE CONTACTED MORE THAN 18,000 DISTRACTED DRIVERS SO FAR THIS YEAR, WHICH IS UP FROM 2017 WITH JUST OVER 17,000 CONTACTS. UNDER STATE LAW, DRIVERS ARE PROHIBITED FROM USING A PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICE WHILE DRIVING ON A PUBLIC HIGHWAY, AND WHILE STOPPED IN TRAFFIC OR AT A TRAFFIC LIGHT. ELECTRONIC DEVICES INCLUDE CELL PHONES, LAPTOPS, TABLETS AND GAMING DEVICES. DRIVERS ARE ALLOWED MINIMAL USE OF THEIR FINGER TO SWIPE THE DEVICE AS A MEANS OF ACTIVATING OR DEACTIVATING IT. HE SAYS THE CLONES APPEAR TO HAVE THE NAMES, ACCOUNT NUMBERS AND PIN NUMBERS OF LEGITIMATE CARDS, EVEN WHEN THE OWNER STILL HAS THE REAL CARD IN THEIR POSSESSION. HE ADDS IT'S STILL UNCLEAR HOW THE INFORMATION WAS STOLEN, BUT SAYS IT COULD HAVE BEEN A DATA BREACH OR MORE LIKELY A CARD SKIMMER. AT LEAST ONE SUSPECT IS DESCRIBED AS A BLACK MAN WITH A JAMAICAN ACCENT AND THE SECOND SUSPECT IS DESCRIBED AS A CAUCASIAN WOMAN. BLATMAN SAYS THEY ALSO GOT MORE INFORMATION THAT TWO MORE MEN COULD BE INVOLVED. MOST OF THE ACTIVITY TOOK PLACE LAST WEEK, INCLUDING LARGE MONEY ORDERS AND ATM TRANSFERS. THERE HAVE ALSO BEEN REPORTS MADE IN RICHLAND, PASCO AND WEST RICHLAND. BLATMAN SAYS IN CASES LIKE THIS VICTIMS USUALLY FIND OUT DAYS LATER: "THAT'S WHAT THEY PEOPLE ARE COUNTING ON. TO AVOID BECOMING A POTENTIAL VICTIM, BLATMAN SAYS PEOPLE SHOULD CHECK THEIR FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS OFTEN AND SET UP ALERTS FOR WHEN A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF CASH IS SPENT OR TAKEN OUT. "BE DILIGENT. THAT'S THE MOST IMPORTANT THING. THIS IS NOT A CASE WHERE SOMEBODY WAS NOT PROTECTING THEIR PIN. IT'S NOT LIKE SOMEBODY IS LOOKING OVER THEIR SHOULDER. IT'S ACTUALLY BEING USED AND THAT MAKES THAT MUCH MORE DIFFICULT." OFFICERS USED FORCE TO END THE BRAWL, BUT PICKETT SAID IT WENT TOO FAR. "THEY'RE NOT JUST GUARDIANS OF US PHYSICALLY. THEY'RE ARE GUARDIANS OF THE PUBLIC TRUST AND WHEN YOU SEE THINGS LIKE HAPPENED ON THE VIDEO TAKE PLACE THERE'S A BREAKING OF PUBLIC TRUST," HE SAID. IN RESPONSE TO WHAT HAPPENED, YAKIMA POLICE PLACED 31-YEAR-OLD OFFICER IAN COLE ON DESK DUTY WHILE AN INVESTIGATION FOR THE USE OF FORCE IS CONDUCTED. IN A PREVIOUS INTERVIEW WITH KIMA, INTERIM POLICE CHIEF CAPTAIN GARY JONES SAID IT COULD

TAKE A FEW WEEKS TO DETERMINE IF THE ACTIONS OF COLE WERE JUSTIFIED. "WE HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY TO DO A THOROUGH COMPLETE INVESTIGATION," HE SAID. HOWEVER, PICKETT SAID THAT'S WHERE THE PROBLEMS LIES. POLICE INVESTIGATING POLICE. HE SAID THE INVESTIGATION FOR JUSTIFICATION, RATHER THAN TRUTH, SLANTS EVERYTHING IN FAVOR OF THE OFFICERS. THE FAMILY WANTS JUSTICE, BUT PICKETT SAID THEY ALSO WANT POLICE TO BE HELD ACCOUNTABLE FOR THEIR ACTIONS BY BEING HELD TO THE SAME STANDARD AS CIVILIANS WHEN FORCE IS USED. "IF YOU STAND UP AND SAY I'LL HANDLE THAT MYSELF. I'LL INVESTIGATE MYSELF. EVERYBODY WOULD SAY THAT'S UTTER NONSENSE AND IT'S NOT CREDIBLE," HE SAID. WHILE THE VIDEO CAN SHOCK PEOPLE ON THE SURFACE, CAPTAIN JONES SAID YAKIMA POLICE ARE STILL COLLECTING EVIDENCE AND CONDUCTING INTERVIEWS WITH WITNESSES TO GATHER AS MUCH INFORMATION AS POSSIBLE TO MAKE A PROPER JUDGEMENT. "CERTAINLY, THE COMMUNITY IS GOING TO HOLD MY OFFICE AND MY DEPARTMENT ACCOUNTABLE FOR OUR ACTIONS. PARTICULARLY IF IT'S IMPROPER ACTIONS AND I WILL DO THE DO THE SAME FOR MY OFFICERS," HE SAID. ONCE A CLAIM IS FILED IN COURT AFTER THE INVESTIGATION IS COMPLETE, PICKETT SAID IT'S UP TO THE CITY FOR WHAT'S NEXT. IF IT'S IGNORED, HE SAID THE POLICE DEPARTMENT WILL BE FACING A LAWSUIT FOR WHAT HAPPENED.

A RICHLAND HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR SAYS THE WALK HAS GROWN BIGGER EVERY YEAR AND HAS ENCOURAGED MORE PEOPLE TO TALK. CHANDRA MARKEL SAYS, "KIDS ARE MORE APT TO COME IN AND SAY, 'I'M STRUGGLING OR I HAVE A FRIEND THAT IS STRUGGLING, CAN YOU HELP?'" RICHLAND HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT SERENA BLUE TUDELLA SAYS HER OLD SCHOOL IN OREGON DIDN'T HAVE A SUICIDE AWARENESS WEEK, SOMETHING SHE THINKS IS CRUCIAL FOR EVERY SCHOOL TO BRING TO LIGHT. SERENA BLUE TUDELLA SAYS, "THERE WERE TOO MANY KIDS WHO I LOST IN THE HALLWAYS OF MY OLD SCHOOL, I THINK IT'S VERY IMPORTANT WE TALK ABOUT SUICIDE AND START A CONVERSATION." EL PRESIDENTE SENIOR Y DE DECA, SYDNEY CATER, DICE QUE TODOS LOS DÍAS DURANTE EL ALMUERZO ESTA SEMANA, SE HA ESTABLECIDO UN PUESTO DE PREVENCIÓN DE SUICIDIOS, PARA INFORMAR A LOS ADOLESCENTES Y BRINDARLES INFORMACIÓN SOBRE LOS RECURSOS LOCALES.
