"News Leader 9 on NBC 38" is the station's news identity since all content is produced live for WLTZ by the WTVM staff. WTVM has a dedicated staff of journalists, meteorologists, sportscasters, and photographers. When news breaks in the Chattahoochee Valley, WLTZ offers vital breaking news, severe weather coverage and local sports coverage serving our audience in two states: Georgia and Alabama, and in two time zones: Central and Eastern.

In addition to live, local morning and evening newscasts seven days a week, WLTZ is unique in offering the West Georgia and East Alabama audience with the area's only 4:00 P.M. weekday live, local newscast.

We are dedicated to providing our viewers with timely and accurate news coverage that adds value to their lives. Issues that are of concern to every viewer are reported each day in each newscast on WLTZ. Whether it involves government, education, the economy, health care, crime or politics, each topic is given the emphasis it deserves to help inform and educate our viewers. News anchors for WLTZ NBC 38 are Cheryl Renee, Ben Stanfield, Dee Armstrong, Jason Dennis and Barbara Gauthier. WTVM supplies WLTZ with the services of four credentialed meteorologists to provide up-to-the-minute live severe weather coverage 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

Meet The Press is a weekly American television news/interview program airing at 9:00 A.M. It's the longest running television series in American broadcasting history, despite bearing little resemblance to the original format of the program seen in its television debut on November 6, 1947. The longevity of Meet the Press is illustrated when one considers that the program debuted during what was only the second official "network television season" for American television. One historical landmark of the program is that it was the first on which a sitting U.S. president, then Gerald Ford appeared on a live television network news program, which occurred on the November 9, 1975 broadcast.
