- CHILD SAFETY: Resilience in School Environments (RISE) program to reduce abuse & neglect among Spokane students
- city development: outgoing Spokane Mayor David Condon's "One Spokane" initiative, one of his proudest accomplishments in his 2 terms
- college tuition assistance: Two Washington state programs that can help Spokane families save for college: GET and DreamAhead.
- Environmental Conservation: The Farm & Food Expo + other programs that protect and conserve natural resources in Spokane County
- higher education & employment: the best paths to college & career training after high school, for Spokane students & parents
- Homeless, helping the: the services Union Gospel Mission provides for the homeless in Spokane
- legislative transparency: two proposed Washington state car laws: a Road Usage Charge & Initiative 976 for a car tab fee cap
- tourism in Spokane: A fee collected by hotels, sent to the Legislature, then given to destination marketing groups such as Visit Spokane and Spokane Sports Commission.
- youth leadership development: Motivating Spokane youth to help victims of sexual assault and human trafficking
