A green alert...US Army divers are taking part in an exercise off the coast of Florida to remove over 700,000 tires that are strewn underwater. As we mentioned previously, these tires ended up there when, over 30 years ago, an oceanographer, helped by dozens of volunteers, decided to create an artificial reef to attract thousands of fish. Unfortunately, the results were catastrophic. The tires scattered over 35 acres – an area equivalent to 31 football fields – and would crash into live corals every time the tide came in and threatening marine life. It is estimated that it will take the divers three years to clean up the area.
