30 minute program

Issues Covered: Education and Mentoring and Economic Issues

Guest: Jenny Harper the Market President of Big Brothers Big Sisters Greater Dallas

Topic: The month of January is National Mentoring Month, a time set aside to raise awareness about the importance of mentoring and the impact that it has on the lives of young people. Jenny Harper from Big Brothers Big Sisters Greater Dallas joined me to talk about mentoring thru Big Brothers Big Sisters and the need for more mentors. We talked about who can become a big and how the organization finds the littles and how they connect them with their mentor. Jenny talked about the time commitment that they expect from those who volunteer to be Bigs and the impact that the Bigs have on the lives of young people. Jenny shared the story of Bigs in Blue which pairs a little with someone in law enforcement and Operation Bigs which helps children who have a parent in the military and also their program that helps those who have an incarcerated parent. They even have a program that partners people in retirement, assisted living and senior groups with young people and how it helps all of those involved. Jenny also talked about her own experience being a Big Sister to Kimberly who she mentored all thru Kimberly’s high school years and how proud she is of Kimberly who is now the first in her family to go to college.

January 8, 2023

Issues Covered: Animal Rights and Protection, Economic and Education Issues

Guest: Jordan Craig the Executive Director of the Spay Neuter Network

Topic: With the start of the New Year the Spay Neuter Network has kicked off their Happy Neuter Year Campaign to raise awareness about the importance of neutering animals with low cost spaying and neutering during the month of January where they will be providing 20 dollar spay or neuter surgeries for dogs and cats. Most people will not spay or neuter their pets due to economic issues or because of time constraints and the Spay Neuter Network does what it can to deal with this obstacles so that they can bring down the population of unwanted pets. Jordan talked about the services and programs provided by the Spay Neuter Network including their mobile clinic and educational outreach. We talked about how they deal with feral cat colonies in North Texas and how they work with the North Texas cities to tackle pet overpopulation and also we discussed ways the community can help them with their mission to eliminate pet overpopulation thru spay neuter services.

January 15, 2023

Issues Covered: Mental Health Issues and the impact of the economy and the pandemic on our mental health.

Guest: Bonnie Cook the Executive Director of Mental Health America of Greater Dallas

Topic: It's a new year and instead of focusing on being physically fit in the new year Mental Health America of Greater Dallas is hoping people will focus on being mentally fit in the new year. Bonnie Cook joined me to talk about how people can take care of themselves and their loved ones during times of stress whether due to the after effects of the pandemic or due to economic stressors. We also talked about the increase in teen suicides and the mental health of young people and how social media is impacting them and how they are becoming less connected with fewer in person human interactions. Bonnie talked about the work that Mental Health America of Greater Dallas does to help those who are struggling with depression, anxiety, bi-polar disorder and other mental health issues. We talked about their programs for young people and young kids and about how their mental health screenings which are free to people in North Texas went from a couple of hundred a month to well over a thousand screenings a month, We also promoted their upcoming Adolescent Symposium which focuses on mental health issues facing teenagers and adolescents.

January 22, 2023

Issues Covered: Education and Economic Issues and the impact that Covid is having on our education system.

Issues Covered: Human Trafficking and Economic Issues

Guest: Bianca Davis the CEO of New Friends New Life

Topic: The month of January is National Human Trafficking Prevention Month a time to raise awareness about the issue of human trafficking and to educate the public about the reality of this crime and how prevalent it is here in North Texas. Bianca Davis joined me to talk about New Friends New Life a North Texas nonprofit that not only raises awareness about the issue of human trafficking but that also restores and empowers formerly trafficked and sexually exploited teen girls, women and their children. Bianca talked about her meeting earlier this week with U.S. Senator John Cornyn and North Texas law enforcement officials where they talked about ways of combatting this crime and how the community can help by being on the lookout for people who may be victims of human trafficking. We talked about how many victims are hiding in plain sight and how to know the signs that someone may be a victim of human trafficking. We also talked about what makes someone vulnerable to traffickers and the threat that the internet poses especially to young men and women. We talked about the economic issues that make someone vulnerable and that also keeps someone in the life as a victim of sexual exploitation and we talked about how family violence at home can make young people vulnerable as well.

January 29, 2023

Issues Covered: Drugs and Alcohol Abuse and Prevention

Guest: Heather Ormand the CEO of Nexus Recovery Center

Topic: Coming up next Sunday CNN will air the documentary American Pain which is about the rise and fall of identical twins from Florida who trafficked over 500 million dollars in opiod pills while running sham clinics. The documentary not only focuses on those who are addicted to pain pills but on the great lengths that people go in order to get relief. The opiod epidemic in the United States keeps getting worse with more and more people dying as a result. Heather Ormand with Nexus Recovery Center joined me to talk about the opiod epidemic and how it is impacting families in North Texas. We talked about the disease of addiction and the services and programs that are offered by Nexus Recovery Center to help women battling addiction and how Nexus is one of the only rehabilitation centers that allows women to be joined by their kids so that they are not separated. According to data from the Department of Health and Human Services 4 in 10 foster kids right now in the U.S. are in the foster care system because of parents with substance abuse issues but with Nexus accepting mothers with children the foster care system is not burdened with the care of those children and many women will forego treatment so as not to lose their children so it is a win win.

February 5, 2023

Issues Covered: Economic Issues and Education Issues

Guest: Mary German the Founder and Executive Director of Travel and Sports Legacy Foundation

Topic: Next Sunday is Super Bowl Sunday, one of the biggest sporting events in the world. The event will bring in millions of dollars to the local economy in the Phoenix area and for anyone who has ever considered a career in sports and travel the big game is the epitome of that career. Here in North Texas, the Travel and Sports Legacy Foundation is a nonprofit that provides job training, scholarships, mentoring and internship placement assistance for underserved youth and adults interested in this career path. Mary joined me to talk about how the foundation began and how students and young adults can take part in the programs. We also talked about the need to get a labor force for all of the sports teams in the North Texas area and how the idea of the foundation should be adopted by other cities here in our area to help find and train employees for teams like the Dallas Stars, the Mavericks, the Roughriders and FC Dallas. Mary talked about working with the Arlington School District and how they provide scholarships to students who have been thru their programs who want to get degrees and we talked about staffing shortages and the current economic outlook and best practices to deal with economic downturns.

February 12, 2023

Issues covered: Health Issues and Mental Health Issues

Guests: Dr. Ann Marie Navar a Cardiologist with Parkland Health and an Associate Professor of Cardiology at UT Southwestern Medical Center and Kevin Hall the President of the Grant Halliburton Foundation

Topic: It is Super Bowl Sunday and in light of what happened to Buffalo Bills star Damar Hamlin the NFL has teamed up with the American Heart Association to offer up free CPR training during the NFL Experience which happens the week ahead of the big game in the host city. The NFL says it is committed to raising awareness about heart health and what to do in case of an emergency such as what happened to Damar Hamlin who suffered a cardiac event in a playoff game and who was saved by an assistant athletic trainer who immediately started CPR. Joining me today was Dr. Ann Marie Navar a Cardiologist who talked about what happened to Damar Hamlin and the importance of knowing CPR and who also talked about heart health since the month of February is Heart Health Awareness Month. Dr. Navar talked about diet and exercise and knowing your numbers whether it is blood pressure or cholesterol and how to identify signs and symptoms of heart disease. Kevin Hall the President of the Grant Halliburton Foundation joined me for the last segment of the program to talk about the upcoming Beacon of Hope Luncheon that will benefit the Grant Halliburton Foundation and their work to provide mental health resources to young people and their families. The luncheon will feature Dallas Cowboy Quarterback Dak Prescott who will speak about his families struggles with mental health. Kevin also talked about the services and programs offered by the Grant Halliburton Foundation. We also talked about their community engagement efforts in schools and with community groups that work with young people in teaching kids about bullying prevention and resilience.

February 19, 2023

Issues Covered: Mental Health and Music Therapy and Education

Guests: Jim Newton the founder of Kidlinks and Sara Chigani a board certified music therapist

Topic: Jim Newton with Kidlinks and Sara Chigani a board certified music therapist joined me to talk about the work that Kidlinks does to help children who are hospitalized or who are traumatized thru music therapy. Jim talked about their therapeutic music entertainment program and the age group that they work with and the impact that they are making. He also talked about how families can go online for free music therapy programs. Sara talked about the changes she sees when she is working with a child dealing with a health issue or with a trauma. Research has shown that music therapy can help manage pain and discomfort, reduce anxiety and stress and can help with socialization and self-expression as well as help with speech and language and motor skills. We also talked about the upcoming benefit The Symphony of Chefs which will raise funds for Kidlinks and that will be held on February 28th.

February 26, 2023

Issues Covered: Discrimination and Bigotry and Hate Crimes

Guests: Rob Crane the co-founder of Together We Dine and Together We Can who is the moderator of the Dallas Bar Association's upcoming panel discussion Restoring Hope and Moving Forward in Reconciliation and Kirsten James the

Executive Director of Project Transformation.

Topic: Last month all eyes were on a synagogue in Colleyville after a terrorist stormed in during services and held the rabbi of the synagoe and several congregants hostage because of their Jewish faith. In the aftermath of the attack the Dallas Bar Association along with Faith Forward Dallas decided to do a public forum to talk about hate in our community and how to come together and bring all faiths together in hope and reconciliation. Rob Crane talked about the public forum and how people could participate and also the programs designed to help people understand people of other faiths and not come from a place of fear. We talked combatting anti-semitism and racial discrimination. My next guest was Kirsten James the Executive Director of Project Transformation a nonprofit that works in underserved communities to mentor kids and to help with homework and literacy. Kirsten talked about their literacy programs at churches in underserved communities and about their summer camps that focus on literacy and the importance of improving literacy rates in children K-5th grade.

March 5, 2023

Issues Covered: Economic Issues, Education and Women's Rights

Guest: Miki Woodward the President and CEO of Texas Women's Foundation

Topic: March 8th is International Women's Day, a global day celebrating the social, economic, cultural and political achievements of women. Miki Woodward joined me to talk about how the Texas Women's Foundation works towards advancing economic security and leadership opportunities for women and girls in North Texas and we talked about the impact that Covid 19 has had on women in the workforce with more and more women leaving the workforce to take care of kids who were not able to go to school because of the pandemic and no child care to care for the children while they worked. We talked about the economic hurdles women must deal with in the workforce due to the lack of equal pay for equal work and we talked about how helping women helps families since so many families in North Texas are headed up by single moms. We talked about the impact that inequality has on our economy as a whole and how the foundation helps girls follow their educational goals.

March 12, 2023

Issues Covered: STEM Education and Economic Issues and the Perot Museum of Nature and Science

Guest: Dr. Linda Silver the CEO of the Perot Museum of Nature and Science

Topic: Dr. Silver joined me to talk about everything that is going on at the Perot Museum ahead of Spring Break in North Texas. We talked about the impact that the pandemic has had on the museum and how finally things are opening back up. We talked about the exhibits currently at the Perot Museum that help kids with STEM Education from the Legos exhibit to the Let's Get Robotic program happening during Spring Break 2022. We also discussed the museums community outreach with their Tech Truck Fleet that goes to underserved zip codes to teach kids about Science, Technology and Math and to engage young students to become interested in science. We also talked about the museum's efforts in helping North Texas educators thru their online programs that offer up curriculum to school districts.

March 19, 2023

Issues: Emergency Preparedness, Economic Issues and Blood Supply

Guest: Dr. Linda Braddy the CEO of the American Red Cross North Texas Region

Topic: The month of March is Red Cross Month and Dr. Linda Braddy joined me to talk about all that the Red Cross does here in North Texas to help the community and with Spring Storm season kicking off earlier than usual with tornadoes ripping across our area this past Thursday we highlighted the importance of people having a safety plan and being Red Cross ready in case of severe weather. We talked about the Red Cross Emergency App that has all the information you need and provides instant access to weather alerts. We also talked about the need to donate blood at any Red Cross Blood Center and we talked about the work that they do to help families following a house or apartment fire. We also talked about their April Home Fires Sound the Alarm Campaign aimed at getting people to install smoke detectors for fire safety. Dr. Braddy also shared other programs that the Red Cross offers to help people in North Texas including CPR training and certification classes for babysitters and lifeguards and we talked about their swim classes.

March 26, 2023

Issues Covered: Combatting Discrimination and Bigotry

Guest: Cheryl Drazin the Vice President of the Anti Defamation League's Central Division

Topic: More and more we are seeing instances of hate crimes across our country with the FBI reporting that hate crimes are at

their highest level in 12 years and hate crimes against Asians is up by 339 percent. Cheryl Drazin with the ADL joined me to talk about the work that the ADL does to fight against discrimination and how they are combatting online hate and discrimination and the advocacy they are doing at the local and national level to make sure that laws protect people. We also talked about the upcoming Walk Against Hate in Dallas at the American Airlines Center in Dallas on April 3rd and how people can get involved and raise their voices against bigotry and bullying. We talked about the ADL's education programs for schools called No Place for Hate and the curriculum available online for educators and we talked about how the ADL is the global leader in exposing extremism and the efforts that they have to help people around the world who are facing discrimination including the people of Ukraine who are currently at war with Russia.
