PUBLIC AFFAIRS PROGRAMS FOR 2nd QUARTER 2020

Because of the Coronavirus Pandemic we ran a National I Heart Program with experts in their field "Coronavirus Explained."

June 14, 2020

Aired 6am to 6:30am

30 minute program

Issues Covered: Home Ownership, Housing, Economic Issues.

Guest: Tosha Herron Bruff the Vice President of Government Relations for Dallas Area Habitat for Humanity.

Topic: The month of June is National Homeownership Month. It is a time to reflect on the impact that home ownership has on a family, a neighborhood and on the economy as a whole but for many the dream of homeownership seems beyond their reach and that is where nonprofits like Habitat for Humanity can help. Habitat for Humanity works with families to find a path to home ownership with the clients of Habitat putting in their own sweat equity to get in to a home but also they need to prove that they have good credit and that they make enough to sustain a home. Habitat has education classes for families even those who don't qualify to get a home can learn how to take steps to get in to a home and how to maintain a home and during Covid 19 the classes have gone virtual and coming up on Saturday, June 27th Habitat will have a virtual Home Ownership Meeting for anyone in the metroplex looking to purchase a home. We also talked about the advocacy that Habitat does with lawmakers at the state level and the national level to make sure that there is affordable housing in cities and how the issue of affordable housing impacts the economy with many companies deciding not to move to an area if there isn't enough affordable housing for their workforce.

June 21, 2020

Aired 6am to 6:30am

30 minute program Issues Covered: Men's Health and Education and Community Involvement.

Guests: Dr. Parth Shaw with USMD Fort Worth Hospital

Topic: Today is Father's Day and Dr. Parth Shaw joined me to talk about men's health issues and what all men need to know about taking care of their health especially during the age of Covid 19. We talked about signs and symptoms of heart disease and cancers that affect men like prostate cancer, testicular cancer. We also talked about low testosterone levels or Low T and how it can affect men in different ways and what to do if you have Low T and we also talked about mental health issues and stress reducers for men and the part that families play in making sure that the men in their lives take care of themselves.

June 28, 2020

Aired 6am to 6:30am

30 minute program

Issues Covered: Support for Law Enforcement

Guest: Sgt. Mike Mata the President of the Dallas Police Association

Topic: It is the Sunday before the 4th of July and as we all get ready to celebrate our nation's independence we also need to reflect on the freedoms we enjoy thanks to the sacrifices that our military and their families have made but we are also faced with a new reality in the age of Covid 19 and in the age of racial injustice protests that have been taking place over the past month around the country. Sgt. Mata joined me to talk about the measures that police are taking to make sure that they are doing their part to end police brutality and the work that they are doing to make sure that communities are safe. We talked about the grievances that people have with police and we talked about the ways that police are bridging the gap. We also talked about policing in the age of phone video and the defund police movement which he says police are for if it means that they will not have to deal with social issues like mental health crisis calls or calls to deal with a child who isn't doing their homework. He talked about how police are being asked to do too much instead of protecting the community and law enforcement. We talked about working with social service agencies but the cost and how communities need to do their part as well.

KZPS Appearances and Events for Non Profits

As a result of the Coronavirus Pandemic I Heart Media stations suspended all in person appearances and events were canceled but we took to the airwaves and to our websites to let listeners know they were not alone and we shared information about resources available to them through United Way and through Communities Foundation of Texas as well as the North Texas Food Bank and the Tarrant Area Food Bank.

April 2-May 15 KZPS supported March for Babies Virtual Celebration and Fundraiser. March for Babies helps raise funds to help new and expectant moms. KHKS was able to support the event with inclusion on our community events calendar to raise awareness of the cause and help generate donations for the virtual campaign.

April 2- May 25 KZPS has shown support for the Healthcare Heroes in the community fighting on the frontlines of COVID-19 by recognizing them on-air by name, title and place of work. KZPS recognized a healthcare hero per jock shift. 5 shifts per day.

April 2- May 25 KZPS has shown support for the local businesses in the community that are still open or considered essential during the pandemic. KZPS did so by recognizing local business on-air by name and location. KZPS recognized local businesses in every day part every day.

April 20-May 31 KZPS supported the North Texas Food Bank with a virtual food drive. The North Texas Food Bank has seen an increase in people seeking food banks for food during the pandemic. KZPS supported with recorded mentions, live mentions, homepage exposure, inclusion in e-blasts and on social media.

May 2nd KZPS supported the American Cancer Society Relay for Life. Relay For Life, the American Cancer Society's signature event, celebrates cancer survivors. Traditionally the family-friendly events were held on outdoor tracks with teams walking to support cancer research and programs. The American Cancer Society's free helpline received some 25,000 calls last month, with 80 percent of them related to cancer patients' needs related to Covid-19. KZPS was able to support the event with inclusion on our community events calendar to raise awareness of the cause and help generate donations for the virtual campaign.

May 2nd KZPS supported Staff Meals meal distribution campaign. Staff Meals is a non-profit that provides 2,400 free chef-crafted meals per weekend to hospitality industry members in-need. KHKS was able to support the event with inclusion on our community events calendar and on social media to help raise awareness about this campaign.

April 20-May 31 KZPS supported the North Texas Food Bank with a virtual food drive. The North Texas Food Bank has seen an increase in people seeking food banks for food during the pandemic. KZPS supported with recorded mentions, live mentions, homepage exposure, inclusion in e-blasts and on social media.

On Saturday, June 6th Anna de Haro the Public Affairs Director of I Heart Media Dallas/Fort Worth took part in a virtual information session with the Alzheimer's Association of North Texas talking about the importance of the work that they do and how it impacts the lives of North Texans especially during the stay at home orders. Carter Blood Care has been in critical need of blood donations because of the current pandemic.
