HI I'M GINA MARIE AUGUSTA AND I'M HERE WITH PAT FAHEY TO TALK ABOUT LAW ENFORCEMENT. PAT WHAT ARE YOUR THOUGHTS

WELL GINA MARIE, WITH THE PASSAGE OF THE RURAL PATROL DISTRICT, RURAL PATROLS, THAT MOST VISIBLE PART OF THE COUNTY'S LAW ENFORCEMENT EFFORT IS PROTECTED WITH PERMANENT SECURE FUNDING, BUT WE MUST REMEMBER THAT THERE IS MORE TO PUBLIC SAFETY THAN RURAL PATROLS. WE MUST BE PREPARED TO SUPPORT THOSE OTHER FUNCTIONS NEEDED TO MAKE LAW ENFORCEMENT WORK, THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE TO PROSECUTE, THE JAIL TO IMPRISON THE OFFENDERS AS WELL AS JUVENILE DETENTION, THE JUVENILE SHELTER, AND INVESTIGATIONS.

THESE CRITICAL FUNCTIONS ARE SUPPORTED BY THE GENERAL FUND AND SHOULD BE THE 1<sup>ST</sup> PRIORITY OF THE COUNTY'S ANNUAL BUDGET. I PLEDGE TO ALWAYS KEEP OUR SHERIFF AND DISTRICT ATTORNEY AS MY #1 PRIORITY. VOTE PAT FAHEY FOR COUNTY COMMISSIONER POSITION 3 ON MAY 21, 2024. OUR SHORTAGE OF WORKFORCE HOUSING HINDERS JOB GROWTH, THE SHORTAGE OF HIGH-END HOUSING HINDERS RECRUITMENT OF PROFESSIONALS, AND THE SHORTAGE LOW-INCOME HOUSING EXACERBATES OUR HOMELESS PROBLEM. IT'S REALLY BAD.

SO HOW DO WE FIX IT? WE NEED TO LOOK AT EVERY BARRIER TO CREATING NEW HOUSING. WE NEED TO LOOK AT EVERY ADDITIONAL COST WE PLACE ON THE SYSTEM, WHETHER IT BE A SYSTEM DEVELOPMENT CHARGE OR PERMIT FEE. WE NEED TO LOOK AT THE AVAILABLE LAND INVENTORY AND SEE IF WE CAN EXPAND IT BY TAKING ADVANTAGE OF CURRENT RELAXED LAND USE LAWS. THE COUNTY CANNOT DO IT ALONE, WE NEED TO WORK WITH OUR CITIES AS WELL AS THE STATE. BUT THE RESULT WILL BE INCREASED EMPLOYMENT, LESS HOMELESSNESS, AND A MORE VIBRANT COUNTY. WE CAN DO IT AND IT WILL BE WORTH IT. VOTE PAT FAHEY FOR COUNTY COMMISSIONER POSITION 3 ON MAY 21, 2024. THIS AD HAS BEEN PAID FOR BY THE COMMITTEE TO ELECT PAT FAHEY.

NEITHER PROBLEM HAS AN EASY ANSWER, AND THE SUPREME COURT MAY DICTATE OUR ACTIONS BUT I PLEDGE TO WORK WITH THE CITIES OF GRANTS PASS AND CAVE JUNCTION TO FIND SOLUTIONS THAT BOTH RESPECTFUL OF PRIVATE PROPERTY RIGHTS AS WELL AS HUMANE TO THE HOMELESS.
