BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM:	Henson was appointed by the state in 2020 to bring the 5 year academically failing Marlin ISD up to standard with the state's requirements. He stresses academic accountability to the best of each student's ability, accessing tutoring, study and scheduling skills, and parental involvement. He discussed his goals and methods to accomplish that task by making students accountable with firm consequences for not following through. That included delaying June's graduation ceremonies by several weeks until the large number of wayward students made up for the missed classes, assignments, and grades. After the first week of school this semester when students delayed and balked, he cancelled all extracurricular activities for one week which included Marlin's first football game of the season. That got attention. He stated, that as a black man in a black majority town, he will not allow (lowered standards). The district is improving and is gaining enrollments. He took on-air calls from pro and con arguments.
