Univision Radio Licensee Corporation ("Univision"), licensee of KISF (FM), North Las Vegas, Nevada, Facility ID 28893 ("KISF" or the "Station"), respectfully submits this response to the above-referenced Notice of Violation (the "Notice").

KISF takes seriously its obligations under the Commission's Rules with respect to its total modulation limitations and acted diligently in response to the Notice. Although we did determine that KISF exceeded 100 percent modulation greater than 75 kHz deviation, as the Notice observed, importantly we note that KISF is operating a 57 kHz subcarrier. Under the Rules, stations using subcarriers may increase total peak modulation by 0.5 percent for each 1.0 percent subcarrier injection modulation up to 110 percent; accordingly, in this instance an 82.5 kHz peak deviation is permissible. 47 C.F.R. § 73.1570(b)(2). KISF therefore believes that at the time of the measurements reported in the Notice, the Station was operating within permissible tolerances.


Nevertheless, and notwithstanding the subcarrier modulation allowance, upon receiving the Notice, the Station reduced its modulation to a level that does not result in more than a 75 kHz deviation. The Station will gladly assist in any further tests or monitoring required to verify its compliance with the Commission's Rules.

I am authorized to respond to the Notice of Violation of behalf of Univision.
