RADIO CAMPESINA HAS MONTHLY SPECIAL CAMPAIGNS:

- **-July:** Knowing the extensive toll that the pandemic and financial crises has had on everyone's mental health, we want to make sure to bring about more awareness about the importance of takin care of our mental health. Minority communities are especially at risk and have the lowest numbers of seeking out help.
