## **Amendment Explanation**

This amendment is being filed to supplement the License Renewal Application with information regarding recently updated Children's Television Programming Reports that have been filed by the Licensee in LMS and uploaded to the Online Public Inspection File.

Quarterly reports from every quarter of 2011 through 2015 were corrected to include a signature from an individual rather than the Licensee entity itself. Quarterly reports from the second quarter of 2013 through the fourth quarter of 2015 were also corrected to list Core Programming in the appropriate section of the reports; in their original state, these reports listed Core Programming in the Non-Core Programming section of the report. Reports for 2020 and 2022 were corrected to reflect the accurate amount of Core Programming in the Digital Core Programming section of the report, and the report for 2020 was corrected to reflect the accurate age range for all Core Programs. All these reports were created in LMS as reports for the year 2022 or 2023 as required by the LMS application program, with an exhibit attached to each stating the time period the report was meant to cover and describing the changes made. These completed reports were then filed in LMS and uploaded to the Online Public Inspection File. Finally, formerly missing Children's Television Programming Reports from the fourth quarter of 2004, third quarter of 2017, fourth quarter of 2019, and 2021 were uploaded to the Online Public Inspection File.
