WVIZ/PBS and 90.3 WCPN **ideastream**<sup>sm</sup> has engaged in the following outreach activities during the year covered by this report:

<i>Activity Classification*</i>	<i>Type of Activity</i>	<i>Brief Description</i>
5	Internship program	<p>There have been 2 graduate level, 9 college level and 3 high school level interns working at ideastream in this past 12 months. Interns gain experience in television and radio production, communications, promotions or development and support of a non-profit organization.</p> <p>Four college level interns worked in TV production, two in radio news area, two in communication/promotions and one in Accounting. In addition, the graduate school level interns worked at <i>ideastream</i> doing research for the radio and web news area.</p> <p>Three high school level interns worked at ideastream supporting the Information Technology and Program needs of the Educational Services Department.</p>

8	Management Leadership Training	<p><i>ideastream</i> continued facilitating the <i>Achieve Global</i> Leadership Development Series for all of the Senior and Middle Management personnel (A total of 30 people). The goal of this series is to provide development for our supervisory employees, intending to increase their skills and focus on better managing their people. During this time period two sessions (4 hours each) have been presented. <i>Giving Recognition</i> was presented in June 2008 and <i>Developing Others</i> was done in September 2008. Also in September 2008 a session called <i>HR 101</i> was presented for all employees with a special session for supervisors. This session was focused on the <i>ideastream</i> policies and procedures surrounding benefits, Performance Management and Policy/Procedures.</p>
11	Careers Seminars	<p>September 11, 2008 <i>ideastream</i> sponsored and broadcast an Interactive Video Distance Learning (IVDL) program to 11 schools with 225 student participants. The topic was <i>Careers in TV Broadcast News</i>. The speaker was Tim White, an anchor for the local NBC affiliate, WKYC TV. Also on IVDL on October 6, 2008 <i>The Town Hall Series</i> presented William Kristol (editor of "The Weekly Standard," columnist "The New York Times" and author) and Eleanor Clift (contributing editor "Newsweek," columnist, author, panelist, etc.) presented a discussion focused on their respective careers. Number of Students: Live audience: (140 students in Westfield) 12 remote school sites (approximately 200 students)</p>

10	Participation in events sponsored by educational institutions	<p>One of <i>ideastream's</i> Producers was a speaker/facilitator for a project at a local school involving 60 7<sup>th</sup> grade boys (all male school). The project involved putting together a radio show – the outcome was a produced radio “show.”</p> <p>Another Producer and a member of our Educational Staff provided a session called <i>Reach</i> for a group of 6-8 grade African American Students for them to explore the inner workings of a TV and Radio Station. This was done on July 10, 2008.</p> <p>A Reporter/Producer addressed several elementary age classes at St. Jude School in Elyria on 10/21/2008. Approximately 40 kids were in attendance total.</p> <p>Then on 5/1/2009 the same Reporter/Producer addressed 35 students at Hale Rd Elementary in Painesville.</p> <p>On 5/4/2009 the Reporter/Producer addressed 50 students at Kensington Intermediate School in Rocky River, Oh.</p>
1.	Job/Internship Fair Attendance	<p>On 11/6/2008 the <i>ideastream</i> HR Manager attended the Career and Internship Expo at Baldwin-Wallace College in Berea, Oh. Emphasis was placed on encouraging students to apply for our summer internships. Resumes were gathered and forwarded to Department Managers for those internships. Students were also informed how to access our Job postings on the <i>ideastream</i> websites for future job vacancies.</p>
1.	Job/Internship Fair Attendance	<p>On 2/27/2009 the HR Director attended the Cleveland State University Career Fair. Summer Internship availabilities were promoted. Students as well as other people who are seeking employment were also informed how to access our Job postings on the <i>ideastream</i> websites for future job vacancies.</p>

1.	Job/Internship Fair Attendance	On 4/8/2009 the HR Director and the Volunteer Coordinator attended a Non-Profit Career Fair sponsored by Case Western Reserve University. The emphasis at this fair was recruiting interns who are interested in working in the non-profit sector. The Volunteer coordinator also recruited volunteers for our annual televised auction fundraiser.
14.	Diversity Focus/Training	The HR Director of <i>ideastream</i> is active in the Diversity Professionals Group which is a program of the Greater Cleveland Partnership. On February 18, 2009 <i>ideastream</i> served as host to this group. Approximately 40 diversity professionals attended. On February 24, 2009 the HR Director and the CEO of <i>ideastream</i> attended a Diversity CEO Breakfast Briefing session where a large number of local CEOs worked on an agenda to review the current state of and crystallize regional goals for economic and workplace inclusion in Northeast Ohio.

1. Participation in at least four job fairs by station personnel who have substantial responsibility in making hiring decisions;
2. Hosting of at least one job fair;
3. Co-sponsoring of at least one job fair with organizations in the business and professional community whose membership includes substantial participation by women and minorities;
4. Participation in at least four events, including conventions, career days, workshops, and similar activities, sponsored by organizations representing groups present in the community interested in broadcast employment issues;
5. Establishment of an internship program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment;
6. Participation in job banks, Internet programs, and other programs designed to promote outreach generally (i.e., outreach that is not primarily directed to providing notification of specific job vacancies);

7. Participation in scholarship programs designed to assist students interested in pursuing a career in broadcasting;
8. Establishment of training programs designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher level positions;
9. Establishment of a mentoring program for station personnel;
10. Participation in at least four events or programs sponsored by educational institutions relating to career opportunities in broadcasting;
11. Sponsorship of at least two events in the community designed to inform and educate members of the public about employment opportunities in broadcasting;
12. Listing of each upper-level category opening in a job bank or newsletter of media trade groups whose membership includes substantial participation by women and minorities;
13. Provision of assistance to unaffiliated non-profit entities in the maintenance of web sites that provide counseling on the process of searching for broadcast employment and/or other career development assistance pertinent to broadcasting;
14. Provision of training to management level personnel as to methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity and preventing discrimination;
15. Provision of training to personnel of unaffiliated non-profit organizations interested in broadcast employment opportunities that would enable them to better refer job candidates for broadcast positions;
16. Participation in other activities designed by the station reasonably calculated to further the goal of disseminating information as to employment opportunities in broadcasting to job candidates who might otherwise be unaware of such opportunities.
