The borders have been closed since March 2020 for nonessential travel.

Moderna said an additional half-dose shot provided a significant immune boost, but FDA scientists indicated Moderna data has not met all criteria for a third dose.

He cautioned people against panicking but said those who are unvaccinated have "good reason to be concerned." Biden announced a plan to distribute 500 million free at-home tests starting in January and more aid for hospitals. Biden also addressed the issue of federal vaccine mandates.
