Other students found themselves stuck indoors, picking up more household chores and responsibilities to help out their essential worker parents.

As they contended with new challenges such as job loss in the family or navigating online schooling, they shared their thoughts and feelings on camera.

Through their eyes, HIKI NŌ had unprecedented access to the in-home experiences of Hawaii’s people during a global pandemic — an experience no other news outlet could truly capture in this manner.

This Changed Everything: HIKI NŌ in the Age of COVID will serve as a historical archive of not only student voice and experience through a global pandemic, but that of their friends, family, and community as well.
