

DESIGNATION OF CHIEF OPERATOR

August 7th, 2017

The Federal Communications Commission requires that the Licensee of a TV Broadcast Station designate a person employed by the Station to serve as a Chief Operator. Accordingly, the person named below is the Designated Chief Operator for KRCW. You will be guided in your duties by the FCC Rules, Article 73.1870.

In the event of the Acting Chief Operator absences, the FCC requires there to be alternate Chief Operators assigned on a temporary basis.

As required by the FCC, a copy of this letter is kept with the stations Operators licenses and the original is in the public file.

According to the Rules, one of the duties of the Acting Chief Operator is to inspect the Transmitter Operator Logs weekly. This means that the Logs must be inspected before eight days have lapsed since the log was created.

The inspection of the Transmitter Maintenance Logs should be handled in the same way.

The remainder of the responsibilities are outlined in the FCC Rules, Part 73.1870 (c)(1)(3)(4).

Your assignment is to perform the duties of the Chief Operator as defined in the FCC Rules so as to meet compliance with these Rules for KRCW.
