Based on ongoing ascertainment, the following iare viewed as the issues significant to our community:

The Economy: Every newscast- 390 total. 800+ Public Service Announcements for all economic agencies and aid organizations including, West Company, Chamber of Commerce. City and County meetings and symposiums plus helpful links online

Housing: Coverage of Planning Commissions for County, Ukiah, Willits, Fort Bragg and Point Arena. 210 newscasts. Gap between stagnant income and soaring housing costs.

Healthcare: As with all, rising costs. Community concerns over churn of health practitioners and increasing need for out of town appointments and procedures Emphasis on Covid has lessened even further but still part of reportage and public service. Tracking apparent rise in Covid in neighboring areas. 210 newscasts, over 900 Public Service Announcements

Environment: Again., coverage of all governmental bodies in including Coastal Commission. 166 newcasts. Excess of 900 Public Service Announcements

Drugs: Coverage of all law enforcement efforts in County. C.A.M.P. and efforts by County Health and Mendocino Coast Clinics. 130 newscasts. Over 1000 Public Service Announcements. Also related as law enforcement reports in almost every newscast.

And, as always, weather and its impacts. Third quarter was better than first and second quarter with moderate rainfall and no major wind events. we still saw County-wide problems with heat inland and the resultant power outages and special bulletins. Also- so far- no major fire events. Every newcast, total of 390, plus constant updates by air staff.

Politics: Daily coverage of Ukraine and internation problems. Ongoing Trump indictments and U.S. politics. 390 newscasts

The Coast continued to cover Education and Recreation/Tourism as major issues affecting our service area

We aired 390 regularly scheduled newscasts in the quarter and over 2500 Public Service announcements, much as last quarter:

The bulk of public service is more economy oriented with information on grants, disaster funds and education, meetings or seminars, webinars and other sources of Information for financial help, education or physical help, food, financial, medical and employment. More emphasis on activities. Emergency coverage as needed, including evacuations, traffic and related problems, working with Sheriff's Office, Calfire and local first responders..
