**QUARTERLY ISSUES/PROGRAMS**

April 1 – June 30 2023

The station has ascertained community leaders and organizations and have identified the following issues as significant in our community:

The Economy: Every newscast- 390 total. 800+ Public Service Announcements for all governmental agency aids, West Company and Chamber of Commerce meetings and symposiums plus helpful links online

Housing: Coverage of Planning Commissions for County, Ukiah, Willits, Fort Bragg and Point Arena. 180 newscasts

Healthcare: As with all, rising costs. Community concerns over churn of health practitioners and increasing need for out of town appointments and procedures. Emphasis on Covid has lessened even further but still part of reportage and public service. 210 newscasts, over 900 Public Service Announcements

Environment: Again., coverage of all governmental bodies including Coastal Commission. 180 newscasts. Excess of 900 Public Service Announcements

Drugs: Coverage of all law enforcement efforts in County. C.A.M.P. and efforts by County Health and Mendocino Coast Clinics. 130 newscasts. Over 1000 Public Service Announcements

And, as always, weather and its negative impacts. Although better than first quarter, we still saw County-wide problems with storms and the resultant power outages, road closures and attendant problems exacerbating supply chain issues were top of mind as much of the first quarter damage is still with us.

Politics: Daily coverage of Ukraine, international problems and U.S. politics. 390 newscasts

The Coast continued to cover Education and Recreation/Tourism as major issues affecting our service area

We aired 390 regularly scheduled newscasts in the quarter and over 2500 Public Service announcements, much as last quarter:

390 newscasts plus dozens of special reports on emergencies outside regular schedule.

The bulk of public service is more economy oriented with information on grants, disaster funds and education, meetings or seminars, webinars and other sources of information for financial help, education or physical help, food, financial, medical and employment. More emphasis on activities. Emergency coverage as needed, including evacuations, traffic and related problems, working with Sheriff's Office, Calfire and local first responders..
