## KOZT-FM/CALIFORNIA RADIO PARTNERS <u>QUARTERLY ISSUES/PROGRAMS</u>

January 1 - March 31 2022

Major changes in this first quarter of 2022. Emphasis on Covid Has lessened as Ukraine coverage takes the front page. Also some local issues dividing the community.

Mendocino Railroad dba Skunk Train has asserted Eminent Domain and purchased over 300 acres of coastal land at far below market value and announced intention of developing the property mostly commercial. Much discussion, many meeting and a lawsuit by the City of Fort Bragg are current results with much more to come.

The Coast continues to cover Economy, Local and County Government, Housing/Urban Improvement, Unemployment/Job Creation, Environment, Healthcare, National Government, Education, Drugs/Substance Abuse and Recreation/Tourism as major issues affecting our service area with a total of 390 regularly scheduled newscasts in the quarter and over 2500 Public Service announcements much as last quarter, but Ukraine/Russia has been the lead in every newscast since March: 390 newscasts.

The bulk of public service continues to be Covid-19 related: especially testing and vaccine boosters, cancellations, meetings or seminars, webinars and other sources of Information for financial help, education or physical help, both food and medical and employment. Three local fires in this periody, so coverage on fire events as needed, including evacuations, traffic and related problems, working with Sheriff's Office, Calfire and local first responders.

We discontinued our twice weekly Covid feature, The Mendocino Coast Health Report at the end of February but continue daily updates from Mendocino County Health. California Governor's Office and related links and information posted to our website and to our social media., including updates on both testing and vaccination sites and clinics, Also providing updates on changing masking and assembly mandates. Staff updates outside of newscasts as information is available or changes.
