CONSUMER NEWS:

5:30P NEWS: ACTION NINE: Four days per week, 2:00 in length. Consumer reporter acts as an advocate for consumers who are not getting satisfaction from businesses or government. Tries to help them solve their own problems or encourage the two parties to work out a solution.

FAMILY FOCUS: One report, two minutes in length, and each week focusing on family and children issues. Reports are part of WSOC-TV's station community campaign: Family Focus, which includes PSA's, events, programs, community projects. Also repeats on Saturday mornings.

TRAFFIC REPORTS: Nine times daily during **EARLY** & **DAYBREAK** and once each during 7:25 AM and 8:25 AM breaks. Includes alternate route information. Also, half hour in midday if there is breaking traffic news.

WHISTLEBLOWER 9 – A report is done bi-weekly on tax-payer waste.

CLARK HOWARD REPORT – Each Saturday morning a segment is aired.

Clark Howard also airs in our 7am/8am on TV 64 and in our 12pm newscast on WSOC from time to time.

9 INVESTIGATES SPECIAL: On Sunday, May 24th from 9p-9:30p WSOC-TV aired a program that focused on local investigations. The anchors and reporters helped uncover stories of government waste, laws being broken, or important stories that impacted viewers in our viewing area in North Carolina and South Carolina.

<u>SUMMER FOOD DRIVE</u> - Channel 9's 10th annual 9 Summer Food Drive collected 22,141 pounds of food during the drive in June.

The food will provide 3,690 meals for a family of four, or 14,761 individual meals.

The food collection is a 35 percent increase from the 2014 collection of 16,000 pounds. Our record year was 23,000 pounds collected in 2008.

Channel 9 employees also filled two barrels with food.

Summer is the most difficult time of the year for the Second Harvest Food Bank and the children that they help to feed. With school no longer in session and more than 265,000 area children currently receiving a free or reduced lunch during the school day, many children will not receive the once-guaranteed two meals a day.

The 9 Summer Food Drive, benefiting The Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina, comes at an especially critical time as area emergency pantries served by SHFBM report increases in requests for assistance and giving is at a low point for the year.

CAROLINA SCHOOL OF BROADCASTING SCHOLARSHIPS

WSOC-TV gave 6 scholarships (valued at \$350 each) for a summer workshop program held in July 2015 at the Carolina School of Broadcasting in Charlotte for junior and senior high-school students from NC and SC. 6 scholarships were given to students interested in the field of broadcasting.
