PROGRAMMING STATEMENT

Radio station KBLJ AM provides a news, information and talk format to its community of license, La Junta, Colorado, on a continuing basis. KBLJ Radio's news, talk, information, and sports programming format is responsive to the main issues of the La Junta area, daily.
