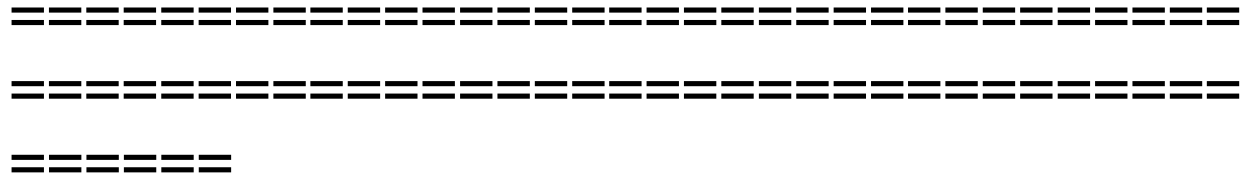

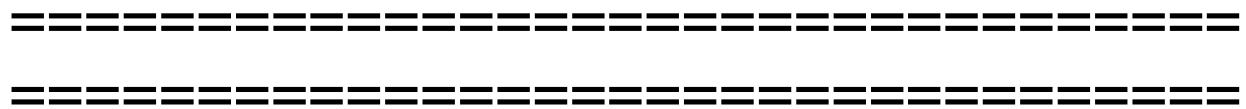

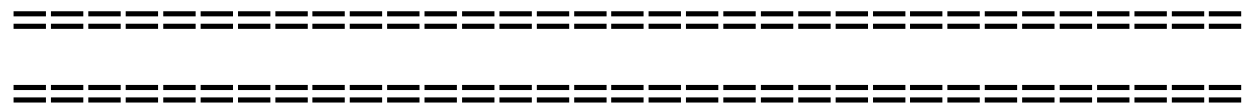
Saturday Market Day
