

Q1 2022 FCC Report write up

In January 2022, we reported Mayor Joe Schember was sworn in as mayor for a second term in the City of Erie, Brenton Davis was sworn in as Erie County Executive, and Jamie Kinder was sworn in as the first woman & black mayor of Meadville.

In Feb. 2022, we reported Erie City Police are working to bring more diversity to the department.

The city's Strengthening Police Community Partnerships Council is hosting an event for those interested in becoming police officers.

For several years, city officials have talked about bringing more diversity to the Erie Police Department.

On February 15th, several Erie city leaders gathered at the Eagles Nest Leadership Corporation on Pennsylvania Avenue to invite members of the community to learn more about the application process for Erie police officers.

In March 2022, we reported Millcreek Township residents will see new rates for waste removal as the current curbside collection contract expires on March 31, 2022. The bid from Waste Management is what will cause residents to face higher rates from the previous contract.

The current quarterly fee will increase to \$87 for 2022 and \$93.09 for 2023. Increased costs of fuel and labor are also contributors of the rising rates.

By 2024, residents will pay a quarterly fee of \$99.61. In 2025, they will pay \$106.58 and \$114.04 by 2026.
