PROTESTS AT GOVERNOR'S MPR OFFICE BOB WELCH

Arrests came two-by-two LAST night inside the lobby of Governor Peter Shumlin's Montpelier office.

The move came after hours of protesting in the state office building by people rallying against the Vermont Gas pipeline that's in the works from Chittenden County through the Middlebury area.

A Shumlin spokesperson says the governor was not in his office but offered to speak to the protestors by phone and was denied. Some protesters claim that offer never happened.

Protestors say they were disappointed they did not get to confront the governor and vowed to be back.

In total, state police say about 60 people were arrested Monday night and cited into court.

Police: 3 FairPoint picketers hit by vehicle

KEENE, N.H. (AP) - Police say three striking FairPoint workers were struck by a vehicle driven by a replacement worker as they were picketing in Keene.

Keene police say one picketer went to the hospital for an evaluation Tuesday afternoon but did not have serious injuries. The two others refused medical treatment.

Authorities say the replacement worker drove across a picket line Tuesday afternoon and hit the three picketers.

Police are still investigating the incident and have not determined if the driver will be charged.

A FairPoint spokesman did not immediately return a phone call seeking comment.

More than 1,700 workers in Maine, New Hampshire and Vermont have been on strike since Oct. 17.

The North Carolina-based company imposed its best and final offer in August after declaring an impasse.

Chamber President Betsy Bishop says it would have been too disruptive if the governor had pushed his plan for an 11.5 percent payroll tax and an income tax up to 9.5 percent. While acknowledging the current financing system is flawed, Bishop says the Governor's plan would have been worse.

Bishop says the state must continue efforts to rein in health care spending. She also said Vermont should spend more money recruting businesses to come to vermon to grow the economy, which she said would take some of the pressure off of health cae spending, enducation spending and make smaller some of the budget gaps, like this year's projected gap of 100 milion

MONTPELIER, Vt. (AP) - Supporters of a state-run single-payer health care plan for Vermont left a plate of mostly burnt toast at the door of Gov. Peter Shumlin's Statehouse office to tell him that's what they think his career is.

Demonstrators gathered first on the Statehouse steps and then went indoors to the doorway of the office Shumlin uses mainly during the legislative session. It was closed. Afterward, they marched through downtown Montpelier to a meeting of the Green Mountain Care Board, the panel that has overseen Vermont's efforts to revamp its health care system.

The tone of the demonstration was unusually angry, with demonstrators chanting, "Which side are you on, Shumlin?"

The event followed Shumlin's announcement Wednesday that he was scrapping his push for a state-funded universal health system, calling it too expensive.

Will there be any doctors in Vermont that don't work for hospitals. One advocacy group is worried.

Health First is an organization that promotes the importance of doctor in practices independent of hopsitals. In Vermont, approximately 75 percent of doctors now work for hospitals.

Amy Cooper of Health First-says advantages to the patient for going to an independent practice can be less cost and procedures that can be done in an office and not in the hospital.

Dr Joe Haddock says he's worried in the push for savings and the way independent doctors are paid by insurance, sometimes less than doctors in hospitals, independent doctors will go away. That reimbusement rate has led some private practices to close and doctors signing up with hospitals.

Hospital officials have said having doctors on staff and paying them a salary can save health care costs, but Cooper and Haddock say studies have shown doctors in a practice independent of hospitals care provides some services more affordably.

The governor-pointed to pockets of opposition on issues including a proposed gas pipeline in Addison-County, wind projects in the Northeast Kingdom and a general anxiety over property taxes as the primary reasons he only narrowly came in with more votes than his republican opponent, Scott Milne. Because no one had more than 50 percet, the election will be decided by the legislature in janary.

In an interview with Radio Vermont, the governor said it was policy issues that people opposed and he dismissed suggestions that some Vermonters do not trust him.

On health care reform, the governor said he planned to outline a plan to the Legislature in January, but he also said he might present more than one plan, but hadn't yet decided. He said he felt there was not a message in the election results to slow health care reform efforts.

The governor said he would do a better job listening to Vermonters and would make himself more accessible. He said over the past four years, he has spent too much time "talking to the same people" and would broaden his public event schedule to talk to more and different people.

MONTPELIER, Vt. (AP) - Vermont's voter turnout appears to have hit a record low in the 2014 elections.

With 99 percent of precincts reporting, The Associated Press calculates that the final turnout figure will be about 193,500.

That's about 43.6 percent of the roughly 443,400 registered voters in the state.

That figure is eight-tenths of a percentage point below the previous low of 44.4 percent of voters who turned out in 1978.

In both that year and this year, there was no presidential race and no U.S. Senate contest in Vermont.
