WLGE serves the needs of Door County and surrounding communities in a variety of formats and timeslots.

Everyday at :50 past the hour from 5am to 6pm we provide a local weather report.

At 7:50a and 11:50a weekdays WLGE airs an "activity board" to inform about things to do and see in the community.

In addition, throughout the day , WLGE provides free public service announcements from 5am to 10pm.

WLGE also airs eTown, a weekly environmental themed show, on Sundays at 9pm.
