This non-profit is extremely new but her and the other co-founder already have a large following of women. They are doulas and founded El Nido to help women here on the borderland with emotional support, lactation support, and empowering women throughout their "reproductive years." She explained how El Nido includes support that is especially important to women in this area because of the unique challenges posed to them on the borderland, including help

Both nonprofits are similar in how they help children. Reach for a Star grants last wishes to terminally ill children. "It's a Debbie Thing" grants wishes for mostly anyone who reaches out to her and involves children. She spoke about how it started, and a few recent events she did including helping a family with a young child whose father had chosen his death date due to his fatal illness. She explained how she needs the community's help to make these events happen and gave some examples of how the community has come together for her in the past.
