TOPIC/SUBJECT DESCRIPTION: Diana and Robert Quesada are father/ daughter and part of the “Friends of the Joint Military Assistance Command.” Robert Quesada is the Brigade Commander and Diana Quesada is the El Paso Unit Commander. They spoke about their duty to give soldiers without family or friends to bury them their “final rights” and how people can volunteer for that. Diana talked about the women empowerment programs that they will be starting in January 2024 for any female somehow connected to the military, (active, veteran, wife, etc). They also spoke about the transitional services they have for veterans, including service dogs. Robert also spoke about an upcoming memorial service for the animals who gave their life in combat/ service.

The 2nd half was talking about hospice care with Bernadette Banda, RN, MSN, MHA, CRRN. It informed the community about what hospice care is, how to apply for it, advice for nurses wanting to go into hospice, and how to care for yourself if you are supporting a loved one on hospice. She was not representing an agency, but informing the community.
