Here are a few of the headlines from stories that aired during newscasts...

July 3

HUNDREDS OF AMERICANS WERE INJURED BY FIREWORKS LAST INDEPENDENCE DAY WITH MANY OF THOSE BELIEVED TO BE CHILDREN. CEO ERIC KOEPPE WITH THE NATIONAL SAFETY COUNCIL OF NEBRASKA SAYS EVEN THE MOST HARMLESS-LOOKING FIREWORKS CAN BE DANGEROUS.

KOEPPE ADVISES KEEPING CHILDREN A GOOD DISTANCE AWAY FROM WHERE BIGGER FIREWORKS ARE LAUNCHED. THAT WAY, IN THE EVENT SOMETHING DOES GO WRONG, CHILDREN CAN STAY SAFE.

July 18

THE STORM PREDICTION CENTER HAS PUT CENTRAL NEBRASKA IN THE BULLSEYE FOR SEVERE STORMS TODAY... THEY SAY LARGE HAIL AND DAMAGING WINDS WILL BE THE PRIMARY THREAT BUT WE COULD SEE BRIEF HEAVY RAIN AND CLOUD TO GROUND LIGHTING. WE COULD SEE SOME STORMS THIS MORNING BUT THE MAIN EVENT WILL BE FROM 4 THIS AFTERNOON TO MIDNIGHT... KEEP IT TUNED TO KRGI FOR THE LATEST WEATHER INFORMATION.

August 9

133 ILLEGAL WORKERS WERE ARRESTED IN NEBRASKA AND MINNESOTA ON WEDNESDAY AFTER A MULTI-STATE OPERATION LEAD BY SPECIAL AGENTS FROM ICE. 17 INDIVIDUALS BUSINESS OWNERS AND MANAGERS WERE ARRESTED FOR ALLEGED CRIMINAL CONSPIRACY TO EXPLOIT ILLEGAL ALIEN LABORERS FOR PROFIT, FRAUD, AND MONEY LAUNDERING.... SEARCH WARRANTS WERE SERVED ON SEVERAL BUSINESSES IN NEBRASKA WITH A MAJORITY OF THEM IN THE O'NEIL AREA BUT ALSO A FEW OTHER LOCATIONS IN NEBRASKA.

GOVERNOR PETE RICKETTS WAS ASKED IF HE WAS CONCERNED ABOUT THE BUSINESSES IN NEBRASKA AFFECTED BY THE RAIDS.

August 20

AFTER MULTIPLE PURSUITS LAST WEEK WITH MULTIPLE AGENCIES 30 YEAR OLD SHANE MELTON OF NORTH PLATTE WAS ARRESTED BY THE NEBRASKA STATE PATROL SWAT TEAM. TROOPERS WERE ABLE TO LOCATE MELTON AND A STOLEN DODGE RAM PICKUP WEST OF LAKE MALONEY - JUST SOUND OF NORTH PLATTE

SUNDAY... MELTON WAS LODGED IN THE LINCOLN COUNTY JAIL ON FOUR OUTSTANDING WARRANTS AND SEVERAL OTHER CHARGES.

Sept 5

AN AMMONIA LEAK AT A LEXINGTON MEATPACKING PLANT SENT MORE THAN A DOZEN WORKERS TO HOSPITAL ON TUESDAY. TYSON FOODS SAYS IN A WRITTEN STATEMENT IT'S INVESTIGATING THE LEAK... THERE WERE NO SERIOUS INJURIES DURING THE INCIDENT.

Sept 20

THE NEBRASKA STATE PATROL IS INVESTIGATING THE DEATH OF A FEMALE INMATE IN GARDEN COUNTY. INVESTIGATORS WERE NOTIFIED OF THE DEATH OF 37 YEAR OLD CANDY FLOOD EARLY TUESDAY MORNING. FLOOD IS FROM SIDNEY BUT WAS BEING HOUSE IN GARDEN COUNTY ON BEHALF OF CHEYENNE COUNTY. PRELIMINARY INFORMATION INDICATES A MEDICAL ISSUES MAY HAVE OCCURRED BUT NEBRASKA LAW REQUESTS A GRAND JURY TO CONVENE DURING ANY IN-CUSTODY DEATHS.
