	Type of Recruitment Initiative	Brief Description of Activity
1	Participate in Job Fair	On Wednesday, September 25, 2019, our SEU participated in a job fair on the campus of the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay. SEU participants included our EEO Coordinator and Promotions Director who spoke with attendees about the SEU's internship program as well as job opportunities within the SEU.

3	Participate in Scholarship Program	During this reporting period, our SEU was an active participant in the Wisconsin Broadcasters Association (WBA) Scholarship Program. Specifically, the SEU's EEO Coordinator and General Manager assisted the WBA by reviewing and evaluating scholarship applications before they were forwarded to the WBA's Educational Committee and Foundation Board for final review. In addition, the SEU promoted the WBA Scholarship Program over the air on each of its stations and answered questions from the listening public concerning the program and the scholarship application process. The SEU also made a monetary contribution to the WBA scholarship fund. On March 7, 2020, four (4) scholarships were awarded at the WBA Students Seminar.
4	Internship Program	Our SEU has an established, on-going Internship Program. Internships with our SEU are advertised over the air as well as on a number of college websites. Our SEU's EEO Coordinator and Promotions Assistant/Intern Coordinator are in contact with local colleges and universities and their internship representatives on a regular basis and work hard to develop these relationships for the benefit of the students as well as the Program.
		The student interns work in the SEU's Promotions, Programming, Sales, Marketing and Development and Sports Departments under the supervision of the SEU's Promotions Assistant/Intern Coordinator. Typical duties include conducting research for stories, assisting with script writing, collecting marketing data, participating in remote promotions/events and interviewing various managers within the SEU to learn more about their specific jobs. All interns earn college credits for completing a semester of work.
		During the Fall of 2019, our SEU hosted one (1) intern from the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh.
