EL DORADO/BUTLER COUNTY ISSUES TO BE ADDRESSED:

A. Mental Health Issues: Youth And Seniors

“Issues Today” – Broadcast January 11th, 12:00 noon. Segment duration 8 minutes. A segment of the nationally syndicated talk show featuring Marni Goldman, Author. Segment featured her story of rebounding from depression. She also talked about ways people can better cope with life.

“Issues Today” – Broadcast January 25th, 12:00 noon. Segment duration 8 minutes. A segment of the nationally syndicated talk show featuring Dr. Gregory Jantz, Psychologist and Clinical Dependency Counselor. Segment discussed the growing teen suicide rate.

“Issues Today” – Broadcast February 15th, 12:00 noon. Segment duration 8 minutes. A segment of the nationally syndicated talk show featuring Melissa Kelley and Elena Burke, Eating Disorder Experts. Segment presented discussion of the growing problem of eating disorders in teens, and how social media influences youth.

B. Health Issues: Lack Of Communication Between Patients And Doctors

Segment exposed flaws in the American health system. Guest also talked about how doctors need to communicate better with their patients.

C. Education And Training Issues: Youth And Worforce
