EL DORADO/BUTLER COUNTY ISSUES TO BE ADDRESSED:

A. Community Safety – Effect from COVID-19

"Happy Hours" – Broadcast March 8th, 3:00 PM; Segment duration 12 minutes. A segment of our locally produced talk/variety show featuring a discussion of petitions by two vaccine manufacturers to implement another round of COVID booster shots. Discussed age groups included in the petition and proposed justifications for this effort.

"Happy Hours" – Broadcast March 22nd, 3:00 PM; Segment duration 6 minutes. A segment of our locally produced talk/variety show featuring a discussion of Kansas Health Department's move to treat COVID as one of many seasonal health problems rather than a priority pandemic.

B. Public Schools – Gender and Sexual Orientation

"Happy Hours" – Broadcast March 1st, 3:00 PM; Segment duration 10 minutes. A segment of our locally produced talk/variety show featuring a discussion of other states' laws regarding discussion of gender and sexual orientation in lower public school grades, and potential impact on Kansas schools. Discussed role of parents and educators in determining lesson content, and mental health of students.

C. Weather Safety

"Happy Hours" – Broadcast March 29th, 3:00 PM; Segment duration 9 minutes. A segment of our locally produced talk/variety show featuring a discussion of current/future severe weather season and local impact regarding shelters, evacuation, and availability of assistance.

D. Public Accommodation/Services - Gender Representation

"Happy Hours" – Broadcast February 22nd, 3:00 PM; Segment duration 9 minutes. A segment of our locally produced talk/variety show featuring a discussion of impact of multiple gender groups on public facilities/activities designed around a binary culture. Examined use of public restrooms, gender-based youth sports, existing laws, and public acceptance.
