

My name is Amanda Pruitt, and I am a teacher at Huntingdon High School. I got your contact information from Lori Nolen who used to work at the Dixie in Huntingdon, TN. She spoke highly of you all. My English IV classes are putting together a career exploration day for our K-12 students. In a nutshell, Huntingdon students (kindergarten through 8th grade) will be visiting and experiencing different careers. We will have different sections for different career clusters.
