In a new "20/20," with reporting by "Nightline" co-anchor Juju Chang, investigators dig into the crime and uncover a sordid tale of infidelity, a crumbling marriage and a husband's alarming past.

She Was Almost Home

In a new "20/20," ABC News correspondent John Quiñones reports on Sierah's disappearance and the investigation that led police to James Worley — a local man with a sinister past and a barn full of dark secrets.

Dearly Departed

In 1981, authorities in the Houston area found a young couple who had been strangled and beaten to death. For 40 years, the victims remained nameless, joining thousands of other unsolved murders in the United States. A breakthrough in 2021 finally revealed the identity of the couple and deepened the mystery — what happened to their missing baby? In a new "20/20," co-anchor David Muir reports on the decades-long hunt for answers, taking viewers inside the multistate investigation that reunited 42-year-old Holly Marie with her remaining biological family.

Friday, November 10, 2023

First Divorced Then Dead

On the morning of July 18, 2014, beloved FSU law professor and father of two young children, Dan Markel, pulled into his driveway and was approached by an unknown man who shot him twice in the head at point-blank range. Detectives found no clues about the perpetrators at the crime scene; they had only one lead to work with — a neighbor who gave a loose description of a Prius speeding out of Dan's driveway. Through a series of interviews and with aid from the FBI, police were able to uncover the travels of the Prius through a web of surveillance footage and toll booth data, which finally led to the arrest of the hitmen responsible for his death. But the question remained: Who hired the hitmen? With reporting from ABC News chief national correspondent Matt Gutman, "20/20" documents how prosecutors used newly enhanced audio as the final link to charge Dan's ex-wife's brother, Charlie Adelson, with the

crime. The two-hour program features an exclusive interview with June Umchinda, Charlie Adelson's exgirlfriend, and additional interviews with Ruth and Phil Markel, Dan's parents, and Michael Weinstein, a former family friend.

The One That Got Out

When authorities found Melissa Ramirez and Claudine Luera murdered and abandoned on the outskirts of Laredo, Texas, they came to a terrifying conclusion over the similarities between the two crime scenes: the city's red-light district had become the hunting ground of a serial killer. In a new "20/20," ABC News correspondent John Quiñones reports on the investigation that ultimately led to one of their own, border patrol supervisor Juan David Ortiz, who was assisting on the case. "20/20" also examines key witness testimony and police body camera video, as well as unpacks Ortiz's nearly nine-hour interrogation that led to his shocking confession.

Friday, December 15, 2023

All American Murder

Antonio Armstrong — a former NFL player turned successful business owner — and his wife, Dawn Armstrong, raised what seemed to be a picture-perfect Texas family. But on a fateful night in July 2016, everything changed when their then-16-year-old son AJ called 911 and reported that he heard gunshots from his parents' room. When police arrived, they found Dawn dead and Antonio fighting for his life — a fight he soon lost — and authorities singled out AJ as the prime suspect. Almost a decade later, the case has gone to trial twice, each time ending in a hung jury. However, bombshell new evidence, previously overlooked, upended the case and finally brought a legal resolution. In a new "20/20," ABC News chief national correspondent Matt Gutman takes viewers inside AJ Armstrong's third murder trial and provides an inside look at the evidence that went undiscovered for seven years.
