Some of KHOE's special sauce comes from its eclectic mix of global music and its wide-ranging, thought-provoking, life-changing intellectual pursuits and offerings. The station slogan is Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam which translates from the Sanskrit as 'the world is my family.'

GLOBAL FAMILY CHAT delivers scientific insight on an array of topics and educational disciplines, as well as positive news from around the world, helpful health protocols, and timely developments at Maharishi International University and the worldwide Transcendental Meditation movement. (airs twice daily)

TM TALKS presents a wide range of inspired topics in the field of personal growth, discussing related issues with scientists, artists, educators, authors, and artisans in the fields of education, health, business, and more. This quarter we began featuring Dr Tony Nader as well with his interviews on consciousness, philosophy and underlying unified principles. (3X weekly)

LOCAL POLITICS continues to provide regular updates from Fairfield's City Council sessions and Jefferson County supervisors meetings, as well as other special segments, like the Carnegie Museum segments on the Heritage Farm families, highlighting those who have owned family farms for more than 150 years in our area, plus special state legislative sessions. Produced by the Fairfield Media Center, these broadcasts keep listeners up to date on city business and issues. (4x weekly)

KHOE is proud to offer cultural education content, in keeping with our mandate as an educational station, from sources like:

~FOOTLIGHT PARADE, produced by the Musical Theater Project. The program is a deep dive into the world of musical theater. Fairfield is the proud home of the Stephen Sondheim Center, the only theater in the country outside New York that bears his name. (3X weekly)

~CLASSICS & BEYOND, produced by Quality Radio Productions in Geneva, New York. QRP is a curated blend of classical music styles ranging from Early Music straight up to contemporary Avant Garde and Experimental compositions. (Weekday mornings)

~SPIRITUAL, ANCIENT & CLASSICAL MUSIC, overnight and early morning, with a special emphasis on classical music forms from the Vedic Tradition, also known as gandharva veda music as well as classical music from many traditions, countries and composers. (Overnight and 9pm-10pm daily)

Three informative 2-min segments air weekdays (5X weekly each):

~*Sound Beat*, produced at Syracuse University Libraries, provides special music segments, film scores and recorded tidbits from across the American musical spectrum, plus speeches and spoken word performances from political figures and historical luminaries.

~*EarthDate*, a production of the Bureau of Economic Geology at the University of Texas at Austin, presents the inspiring natural wonders of earth from the perspective of geoscience

~*The Science and the Sea*, focuses on marine science topics, also produced by The University of Texas at Austin

We've continued the new segment called HOMETOWN HIGHLIGHTS & BEYOND, featuring stories of local interest by writers from the *Iowa Source*, a statewide free monthly based in Fairfield in its 36th year of publication, suggesting things to do, places to see, etc. (3-5x weekly)

We are winding down MISSION: EMPLOYABLE after this quarter which highlighted work-related topics in Iowa, as well as practical suggestions and pathways for those seeking employment. Produced by the Iowa Workforce Development Communications Bureau. (3X weekly)
