Fox Television Stations, LLC ("FTS"), licensee of KMSP-TV, Minneapolis, Minnesota, hereby responds to the above-referenced Notice of Informal Complaint ("NOIC").¹

Ms. Hautala wrote the Commission on March 20, 2015 because she was apparently having problems viewing the closed captioning on *The Following*. No specific dates and times of when the captions were allegedly not functioning were provided. Upon receiving the NOIC, KMSP-TV conducted a spot check of *The Following* and found the closed captions were present and functioning on March 2, 2015, March 9, 2015, and March 16, 2015 (the three episodes that preceded Ms. Hautala writing the Commission). As such, it does not appear any corrective actions are required.
