"Career Awareness;" Station Tours: During this reporting period of June 1, 2019 through May 31, 2020, WTTG/WDCA conducted six station tours for elementary/middle/high school students, educational organizations, charitable organizations, and professionals from the community to explain television broadcast operations.

Minority Training/Scholarship Program: Emma L. Bowen Foundation for Minority Interests in Media – Established in 1989, the Emma L. Bowen Foundation for Minority Interests in Media is a non-profit organization whose mission is to create career opportunities in the media industry for minority youth through a program that focuses on scholastic achievement, direct work experience, and professional development. Students in the program work in media companies each summer and during school breaks, from high school through college. The students earn both salaries and matching scholarship funds to be used for college tuition and related expenses. Over a period of up to five years, the students experience numerous aspects of the corporate operation and develop professional and practical skills that will help prepare them for their careers, many of which begin at the companies where the students interned. Fox Television Stations have been a corporate partner in this program since its inception, and two of the Company's executives are on the Foundation's Board. WTTG/WDCA matches all earned income and applies the same to the college tuition obligation for the student. The student works throughout her college years and has the opportunity to get a job at the station upon graduation, if available. The current student is an African-American female completing her senior year at Hampton University.

"Career Awareness;" Student Outreach Program: During this reporting period of June 1, 2019 through May 31, 2020, WTTG/WDCA conducted four student outreach programs/events with various elementary/middle/high schools and educational organizations to promote broadcast and educational objectives and broadcasting career opportunities.

Employee Enrichment/Training: WTTG/WDCA conducts employee training throughout the reporting cycle to increase current skills and enable the staff to be more effective in their positions. This training included: Finance personnel trained on collaboration tools such as BOX, Slack, Quip; WideOrbit; various professional development online courses; NAB Business Leadership Training; Harvard Manage Mentor Innovation Implementation. Reporters and Photographers received LiveU training and Drone training. Producers and Writers received Luci5 training. News personnel Dataminr and SNIPE training. Sales personnel trained on WideOrbit and sales landscaping. Station employees participated in workplace Active Shooter/Imminent Threat Training. Station employees completed anti-harassment and discrimination training.

Internship Program: WTTG/WDCA participates in the Winterim Program. The Winterim Program began in 1973. This is a three-week program of on and off campus opportunities meant to broaden the intellectual horizons of students. Students have the option of completing an internship during the junior or senior year of high school. Students participate in school-led, pre-internship trainings to prepare for a rich experience. This year WTTG/WDCA hosted a junior from Harpeth Hall School in Nashville, TN from January 8, 2020 through January 23, 2020. This individual was managed by the Stations' Assistant News Director.
