WYLD-FM provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **CHARITABLE:** Promotion of the upcoming Daughters of Charity Gala. This is a fundraiser for an Order of Nuns with a long history of good work in the New Orleans area, particularly in the area of health care
- **CRIME:** This is a Crimestoppers segment on active shooter training. With the school shooting in Florida this past week, just the most recent in a long line, it is more important than ever for police agencies and schools to have a plan in place
- **CULTURE:** The guests are authors of 'Freedom's Dance", this is a detailed look at the social aid and pleasure club parade culture in New Orleans. The book includes a look at how certain rituals developed within the parades
- **EDUCATION:** The Robottom Foundation, which funds a variety of college scholarships for deserving local students. How to apply for the next round of scholarships or make a donation to help support the cause
- **FAMILY SERVICES**: The guest is from the American Foundation of Suicide Prevention. Helping to understand why so many people contemplate and even attempt to carry out suicide. How to recognize the warning signs
- **FINANCES:** The guest is a personal money management consultant and author. Tips for making a budget and sticking to it and tax deductions that many people neglect to take
- **HEALTH:** The guest offers smoking cessation tips for those who want to quit. One important thing to remember is that very few people are able to quit for good the first time they try. The process often involves trial and error
- **MILITARY AND VETERANS:** Discussion of the Vietnam Veterans project in particular the "Wall of Faces", which seeks to put a name with every face etched on the wall. There are presently 8,000 US soldiers either killed or missing in Vietnam who's names are not on the wall
