LAST YEAR THEY WERE THE HEADLINERS AT THE CONSUMER ELECTRONIC SHOW. TODAY THE FOOTPRINT OF FARADAY FUTURE CAN STILL BE SEEN IN SOUTHERN NEVADA. THE CAR MAKER DEBUTED THEIR FUTURISTIC, HI TECH, AUTONOMOUS CAR AT LAST YEARS CES. THEIR FUTURE WAS LINKED TO NORTH LAS VEGAS IN THE WAY OF A TWO HUNDRED MILLION DOLLAR TAX ABATEMENT TO GET THEM TO BUILD A FACTORY AT THE APEX INDUSTRIAL PARK. ONLY THE CAR MANUFACTURER SCRAPPED THEIR NEVADA PLANS AFTER FINANCIAL PROBLEMS. THEY STILL OWN A NINE HUNDRED ACRE PLOT AT THE SITE AND WE'VE LEARNED A TEN MILLION DOLLAR ENGINEERING PLAN TO GET WATER TO THE SITE WAS PAID FOR BY THE COMPANY AND COULD BE USED BY NORTH LAS VEGAS IN THE NEAR FUTURE. IN TOSSING OUT THIS CASE THE JUDGE ONLY RESOLVED THE CRIMINAL ALLEGATIONS THAT RESULTED FROM THE 2014 BUNDY RANCH STANDOFF. 4. Local Electoral Affairs Programming  
Programming which consists of candidate-centered discourse focusing on the local, state and United States Congressional races for offices to be elected by a constituency within the licensee's broadcast area. Local electoral affairs programming includes broadcasts of candidate debates, interviews, or statements, as well as substantive discussion of ballot measures that will be put before the voters in a forthcoming election.
