Community – Homeless Hygiene Kits & Local Teens	News 3 Live at Five	7/18	5:00p	1 min	A GROUP OF LOCAL TEENAGERS HELPING THOSE IN NEED HERE IN THE VALLEY. THREE TEENS WITH THE PROJECT EARTHLY ANGELS DELIVERING FREE HYGIENE KITS AND WATER TO THOSE EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS TODAY. THEIR GOAL IS TO PROVIDE UNHOUSED INDIVIDUALS WITH BASIC NECESSITIES THAT THEY MAY NOT HAVE ACCESS TO. THEY RECIEVED A GRANT OF 5-THOUSAND DOLLARS TO USE TOWARDS THEIR PROJECT. THE TEENS SAY BEING ABLE TO HELP IN THIS WAY MAKES THEM REALIZE HOW CONNECTED WE ARE HERE IN THE VALLEY. IN TOTAL THEY HANDED OUT MORE THAN 600 HYGENE KITS. THE THREE LOCAL HEROS HOPE TO CREATE THEIR OWN NON-PROFIT TO CONTINUE THEIR WORK.

THIS WHILE DOZENS OF TEACHERS UNION MEMBERS CHANT FOR HIS DISMISSAL OUTSIDE AN EVENT IN SUMMERLIN HAPPENING RIGHT NOW. SUPERINTENDENT JESUS JARA IS HOSTING JAVA WITH JARA AN EVENT WHERE COMMUNITY MEMBERS CAN DISCUSS ISSUES IMPORTANT TO THEM. IT COMES AFTER THE RECENT INCIDENT AT THE LAS VEGAS SIGN WHERE POLICE ARRESTED A STREET VENDOR SAYING HE COULDN'T BE THERE. COMMISSIONERS SAY THERE'S A LOT OF CONFUSION ABOUT THE LAW PASSED BY THE LEGISLATURE. THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S OFFICE PLANS TO CREATE A TASK FORCE TO DECIDE WHAT ORDINANCES SHOULD BE ADOPTED. THERE ARE 2 PHASES AS IT STANDS RIGHT NOW, BY OCTOBER 15TH VENDORS CAN'T SELL ON THE STRIP OR NEAR STADIUMS.
