Salud	Despierta América	10/02/2018	0:30	Teen sleep study shows link to risky behaviors. Teens who get less sleep are more likely to engage in risky and suicidal behavior, according to a new study. Researchers used data from the youth risk behavior survey from 2007 to 2015, which explored behaviors related to health risks in American youth. They found teens who slept for less than six hours per night were three times more likely to consider suicide, plan a suicide or attempt suicide, compared to teens who slept eight hours or more.
Economía	Despierta América	10/15/2018	0:30	Sears has filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection, buckling under its massive debt load and staggering losses. The company once dominated the American landscape, but whether a smaller Sears can be viable remains in question. It joins a growing list of retailers that have filed for bankruptcy or liquidated in the last two years amid a fiercely competitive climate. But with its sheer colossal size, Sears' reorganization in court will have even wider ripple effects.
Salud	Despierta América	10/17/2018	0:30	Fall has arrived, and so has the annual flu season. While flu - or influenza - is most serious for older Americans and people with certain chronic conditions, influenza can affect people of all ages and lead to hospitalizations, significant health complications and even death. As many as 35 million flu cases are expected this year, starting in October and continuing into May, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). The peak months are December through February. Most people have likely had the flu at some point - with symptoms such as a constant cough, sore throat, a runny or stuffy nose, body aches, headaches and fatigue - yet many myths and misperceptions remain.

Social	Despierta America	11/01/2018	2:00	A study published this month in the Journal of Family Medicine and Primary Care said 259 people had died taking selfies between October 2011 and November 2017. The report, based on findings from researchers in India who scoured worldwide media reports, said the main causes of selfie deaths were drowning, usually involving people being washed away by waves or falling from a boat, followed by people killed while posing in front of a moving train, deaths involving falls from high places or while taking pictures with dangerous animals. More than 10 people have died at Yosemite this year, some from natural causes and others from falls, park spokesman Scott Gediman said.

Over 48 million people will be hitting the roads, the highest since 2005. A record number of people will also be flying this year. The TSA is expecting to screen 25 million people throughout the week.

The FSIS is recommending that ground beef be safely cooked to 160 degrees and confirmed with a meat thermometer.

The research includes nearly 117,000 adults in 21 countries in seven regions of the planet. however, the research has at least two limitations: it does not take into account the conditions surrounding each participant, and they themselves reported the sleep periods.
Salud	Despierta America	12/07/2018	0:25	Health authorities insist that romaine lettuce harvested in coastal areas of central and northern California should not be eaten. The centers for disease control and prevention have confirmed at least nine new cases of infection with the bacteria "e-coli" since Nov. 26. In total, 52 patients in 15 states, of which 19 were hospitalized and two suffered kidney failure. Fortunately, no deaths are reported.
Salud	Primer Impacto	10/01/2018	0:20	Congenital syphilis is passed on by the mother during pregnancy or delivery, According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the number of cases more than doubled from 2013 to 2017, when the recorded cases hit 918. The CDC says this even outpaces the national increase of sexually transmitted diseases.
Seguridad	Primer Impacto	10/05/2018	0:20	Toyota Motor Corp. is recalling 2.4 million vehicles globally to fix a fault in the hybrid system that could cause them to lose power, According to a Dow Jones report provided to EFE, the recall mainly affects certain Prius variants

				produced between October 2008 and November 2014, the auto maker said Friday. In the U.S., the recall covers more than 800,000 vehicles: the model year 2010-2014 Prius and the larger model year 2012-2014 Prius v. The recall also covers certain hybrid versions of the Auris hatchback, which isn't sold in the U.S.
Salud	Primer Impacto	11/02/2018	0:20	Researchers found a link between high levels of the stress hormone cortisol and brain size and function. Cortisol is a hormone released when we are stressed and on high alert. Researchers say that if you're constantly stressed-- your body may malfunction.
Salud	Primer Impacto	11/13/2018	0:20	The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention is dealing with more confirmed cases of a rare Polio-like illness that mostly affects children. 162-possible cases are currently under investigation. The C-D-C says that's 23 more than last week. A-F-M- as it's known-- is a rare illness that affects the nervous system.
Salud	Primer Impacto	12/04/2018	2:30	Doctor Juan talk about sadness or depression at holiday time. It can be a reaction to the stresses and demands of the season. In other cases, people may feel depressed around the winter holidays due to a condition known as Seasonal Affective Disorder (SAD), sometimes referred to as seasonal depression. He recommended to deal with stress and depression during the holidays: limit alcohol, get plenty of sleep, exercise regularly, avoid overeating.
Seguridad	Primer Impacto	12/14/2018	0:20	The first recall covers about 96,000 Toyota Land Cruisers and Lexus LX570 SUV's from 2008 through 2019. Toyota says a seat belt tension sensor can malfunction and deactivate the passenger's front, knee and side air bags. That would increase the injury risk in a crash. The Company is developing a fix and will notify owners by mid-February. The other recall affects about 47,000 Tacoma Pickups from 2018 and 2019. A brake master cylinder seal can become damaged and leak brake fluid, reducing front brake performance and increasing stopping distances. Dealers will replace the master cylinder. Owners will be notified in late January.
Seguridad/Salud	Noticiero Univision	10/04/2018	1:39	More than 6-and-a half million pounds of beef products distributed by Arizona-based meat producer J-B-S Tolleson are being recalled. At least 57-cases of salmonella illness are linked to this outbreak in 16 states according to the U-S-D-A. The recalled products were packaged between July 26 and September 7th. And were sold under the brand names: Walmart, Cedar River Farms Natural Beef, Showcase, Showcase-Walmart and J-B-S generic. All have the USDA inspection mark "E-S-T-2-6-7".
Seguridad/Clima	Noticiero Univision	10/08/2018	1:55	Florida governor Rick Scott declared today the state of emergency before the prognosis that the tropical storm Michael strengthens quickly and becomes a hurricane next to the northwest coast of the state next week. According to the most recent prognosis of the National Hurricane Center, the phenomenon could make landfall in the Panhandle area on Wednesday.

The recall is the first tied to an outbreak the U.S. Department of Agriculture says is widespread and likely affects a number of different producers in the industry.
Seguridad	Noticiero Univision	12/06/2018	1:42	Health authorities announced the removal of "ibuprofen" for children from CVS pharmacies and Walmart stores. The authorities suspect that three lots of that medication could contain very high doses that could hurt children
Salud	Noticiero Univision	12/10/2018	0:21	Since last week, there are two dozen new confirmed cases of "Acute Flaccid Myelitis". According to the Centers for Disease Control there is no cure or vaccination for this rare disease which causes paralysis. This year there are 158 cases confirmed in 36 states, most in children.
