QUARTERLY ISSUES/PROGRAMS LIST
3rd QUARTER - 2020

Listed below are some of the significant issues responded to by Radio Station KVNN-AM, along with the most significant programming treatment of those issues for the period July 1, 2020 to September 30, 2020. The listing is by no means exhaustive or all-inclusive. These issues were in part ascertained through discussions with service-providers and general interaction of station staff with the community, and staff knowledge of the community and area occurrences. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any particular priority.

The following issues were principal topics or themes within the station's weekly public affairs program, "Issues Today" (IT), which is broadcast on Sunday Mornings at 7:00am. Each program has a normal running time (or length) in the range of 29 to 30 minutes. Each program is usually in two or three parts, each dealing with separate topics and issues.

Racism/Police Defunding - 07/05/20 - IT - Interview with Dainte Johnson, Founder and President of Black Conservative Federation, about the Black Lives Movement, and about police defunding.

Youth/Education - 07/05/20 - IT - Interview with Clint Salter, Entrepreneur and Author, with some tips on how parents can help to select a virtual summer camp for their kids, and about the need for productive activities for youth.

Coronavirus/Health - 07/05/20 - IT - Interview with Gerald Celente, Founder of Trend Journal Forecast, with some predictions for health trends in the country, and about the Coronavirus pandemic.

Economy/Coronavirus - 07/12/20 - IT - Interview with Danielle McCoy, VP and Fair Lending Officer at Fannie Mae, about what help is available for people having financial problems because of Coronavirus, and about state efforts to help mortgage owners.

Defund Police/Crime - 07/12/20 - IT - Interview with Jennifer Braceras, Director of Independent Law Center, about the "defund the police" movement, and about growing crime and looting in the United States.

Coronavirus/Healthcare Costs - 07/12/20 - IT - Interview with Dr. Holly Phillips, Medical Expert for RX Saver, with some tips on how to save money on health procedures, and about innovative medical techniques.

Health Costs/Education - 07/19/20 - IT - Interview with Cynthia Fisher, Founder of Patientrights.org, about new legislation that would make hospital and medical costs more transparent, and about the need for better medical education for the public.

North Korea Tensions/Cybercrime - 07/19/20 - IT - Interview with William Craig, Retired US Navy Submarine Officer and Geopolitical Analyst, about the political situation between the United States and North Korea, and about the growing problem of cybercrime.

Coronavirus/Divorce - 07/19/20 - IT - Interview with Dr. Diana Wiley, Marriage and Family Therapist, about how to improve relationships during the Coronavirus, and about growing divorce rates.

Sexual Abuse/Domestic Violence - 07/26/20 - IT - Interview with Keisha Lonon, Victim Rights Advocate, about the growing problems of sexual abuse and domestic violence, and about new standards that should be adopted.

Youth/Education - 07/26/20 - IT - Interview with Zach Boren, Senior Policy Program Manager, Center for Labor, Human Services and Population, about new efforts to revive apprenticeship programs in the country, and about their efforts to recruit more businesses and students as young as 16.

Political Culture/Big Government - 07/26/20 - IT - Interview with Katherine Gehl, Author of "The Politics Industry", about ways to change the political landscape, and about starting change at the local level and increasing to federal elections.

Health/Youth - 08/02/20 - IT - Interview with Ernie Hudson, Actor and Cancer Prevention Advocate, about his personal story of cancer survival, and about ways the public can get more information about cancer prevention.

Economy/Unemployment - 08/02/20 - IT - Interview with Gene Sperling, Former Obama Administration Chief Economist and Author, about the need for economic equality, and about how everyone should have access to paid sick leave.

Coronavirus/Economy - 08/02/20 - IT - Interview with Paul Skousen, Former Intelligence Officer and Author, about how some individual rights have eroded because of Coronavirus, and about the state of the economy.

Education/College Costs - 08/09/20 - IT - Interview with Eric Tyson, Personal Finance Writer and Counselor, about ways parents can save money on college tuition, and about rising college costs.

Defund The Police/Black Lives Matter - 08/09/20 - IT - Interview with Sam Peters, Founder of Law Enforcement Loyalty PAC, about the defund the police movement, and about the Black Lives Matter and Antifa demonstrations.

Consumerism/Youth - 08/09/20 - IT - Interview with George Geary, Chef and Author, about how the public can make popular fair foods at home, and about the process to obtain recipes.

Gun Control/Crime - 08/16/20 - IT - Interview with Dr. John Lott, President of Crime Prevention Research Center, about the efforts that states are taking to increase gun control, as well as detailing myths about legislation.

Coronavirus/Seniors - 08/16/20 - IT - Interview with Dr. Nir Barzilai, Founder of Institute for Aging Research, with some tips on how people can build up their immune systems naturally, and about how seniors can be more healthy.

Coronavirus/Health - 08/16/20 - IT - Interview with Dr. John Jaquish, Medical Health and Fitness Researcher, about the safety of gyms during coronavirus, and about home fitness programs.

Legal System/Crime - 08/23/20 - IT - Interview with Robert Katzburg, Former Federal Prosecutor and Author, about the growing problem of vanishing juries in federal legal cases, and about the diminishing power of judges in adjudicating cases.

Environment/Economy - 08/23/20 - IT - Interview with Dr. Enric Sala, Ecologist and Author, about how environmental projects are good for the economy, and about the need for better education on climate change.

Medical Costs/Health - 08/23/20 - IT - Interview with Brian Blasé, Economist and Former White House Advisor, about why healthcare price transparency is important, and about efforts on the federal level to get laws to protect consumers.

Taxes/Big Government - 08/30/20 - IT - Interview with Lisa Conyers, Consultant to Private Clients, about the growing problem of crony capitalism, as well as some examples of projects that are helping huge corporations.

Fraud/Big Government - 08/30/20 - IT - Interview with Pete Hutchinson, President of Landmark Legal Foundation, about the growing controversy of mail-in voting, and about the Coronavirus pandemic.

Coronavirus/Economy - 08/30/20 - IT - Interview with Dr. Richard Arrivello, Chief Medical Officer of In-House Physicians, about whether corporate events are safe to attend, and about the effects of a lack of conventions on the economy.

Coronavirus/Depression - 09/06/20 - IT - Interview with Dr. Andrea Klemes, Chief Medical Officer of MDVIP, about the growing increase of depression because of Coronavirus, and about ways patients can deal with it.
