QUARTERLY ISSUES/PROGRAMS LIST
3RD QUARTER - 2017

Listed below are some of the significant issues responded to by Radio Station KVNN-AM, along with the most significant programming treatment of those issues for the period July 1, 2017 to September 30, 2017. The listing is by no means exhaustive or all-inclusive. These issues were in part ascertained through discussions with service-providers and general interaction of station staff with the community, and staff knowledge of the community and area occurrences. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any particular priority.

The following issues were principal topics or themes within the station's weekly public affairs program, "Issues Today" (IT), which is broadcast on Sunday Mornings at 7:00am. Each program has a normal running time (or length) in the range of 29 to 30 minutes. Each program is usually in two or three parts, each dealing with separate topics and issues.

Family Time/Stress – 07/02/17 – IT – Interview with Candace Cameron-Bure, Actress and Motivator, about the importance of family vacation time, and also about popular destinations.

Obesity/Depression – 07/02/17 – IT – Interview with Dr. Daniel Amen, Physician, Psychiatrist and Author, about the relationship between youth obesity and depression, and about steps to fight the problem.

Youth/Education – 07/02/17 – IT – Interview with Dr. Robert Melillo, Co-Founder of Brain Balance Achievement Centers, about ways parents can motivate their kids who are picky eaters, and about the importance of better education systems.

Net Neutrality/Communication – 07/09/17 – IT – Interview with Deborah Collier, Director of Technology and Telecommunications Policy, Citizens Against Government Waste, about the net neutrality controversy, and about the need for less government control.

Environment/Economy – 07/09/17 – IT – Interview with Norman Rogers, Writer for Americanthinker.com, about the alternative energy plans for California and how it might affect the rest of the country, and about effects on ratepayers.

Stress/Communication – 07/09/17 – IT – Interview with Gayle Van Gils, Author of "Happier at Work", about ways workers can be happier at work, and about stress in the workplace.

Women/Family Leave – 07/16/17 – IT – Interview with Hadley Heath Manning, Director of Policy, Independent Women’s Forum, about changes in family policy that are being debated in Washington, and about their organization’s stance on federal and state legislation.

Youth/Poverty – 07/16/17 – IT – Interview with Shelley Callahan, Director of Development for Children, Inc., about their work in helping poor children both around the world and in the U.S., and about their need for more funds.

Youth/Education – 07/16/17 – IT – Interview with Danielle Smith, TV Personality and Spokesperson, about a new app that helps teens manage their money, and about how parents can help with the process.

Crime/Gangs – 07/23/17 – IT – Interview with Dr. Kathy Seifert, Forensic Psychologist, about the psychology of serial killers, and about how some computer models can predict future criminal behavior.

Legal System/Consumerism – 07/23/17 – IT – Interview with Joy Butler, Intellectual Rights Researcher, about the rights that producers have in protecting their intellectual property, and about the need for more consumer information on the topic.

Health/Education – 07/23/17 – IT – Interview with Dave Foreman, Herbal Pharmacist, about the health dangers of sugary drinks, and about supplements that can be ingested for better health.

Distracted Driving/Health – 07/30/17 – IT – Interview with Anson Williams, Actor and Entrepreneur, about the dangers of drowsy driving, and about a new natural remedy to relieve symptoms.

Economy/Cause Capitalism – 07/30/17 – IT – Interview with Steve Down, CEO of Steve Down LLC, about what ‘cause capitalism’ is all about, and about the need for more companies to embrace new ways to operate businesses.

Economy/Consumerism – 07/30/17 – IT – Interview with Dave Hopson, Business Adviser, about ways business owners can weather bad business cycles, and about how to get the word out about entrepreneurship.

Health/Climate Change – 08/06/17 – IT – Interview with Norm Rogers, Publisher at climateviews.com, about climate change policies and how they are affecting the economy, and about big government laws.

Youth/Drug Abuse – 08/06/17 – IT – Interview with Dr. John Huber, Chairman of Mainstream Mental Health, about the millennial lifestyle and

how some in the generation are not adjusting to life as well as others, and about parental behavior.

Consumerism/Stress – 08/06/17 – IT – Interview with Richard Moran, President of Menlo College, with some business travel tips for those who are looking to improve their experience, and about heightened stress during travel.

Terrorism/Political Correctness – 08/13/17 – IT – Interview with Raheel Raza, Journalist and Member of The Council of Muslims Facing Tomorrow, decrying Jihadism and describing the work of her organization, and about other moderate Islam organizations.

Human Trafficking/Crime – 08/13/17 – IT – Interview with Terry Jastrow, Producer and Co-Founder of Artists for Human Rights, about their efforts to improve human rights around the world, and about the growing problem of human trafficking.

Health/Obesity – 08/13/17 – IT – Interview with Fred Cuellar, Author of “The Buffer Zone Diet,” about how his system favors not what you eat but when you eat, and about the need for regular exercise and sleep.

Education/Youth – 08/20/17 – IT – Interview with Dr. Cornelius Grove, Education Researcher and Author, about why public education is now improving in the United States, and about the role parents play in the process.

Cyber-Terrorism/Economy – 08/20/17 – IT – Interview with Robin Burk, Cyber-Terrorism Expert and Author, about the growing threat of Cyber-Terrorism in the country, and about ways individuals can protect themselves.

Sexual Abuse/Youth – 08/20/17 – IT – Interview with Polly Franks, Sexual Abuse Researcher, about ways people can protect themselves from sexual predators in their neighborhood, and about changing laws in different communities.

Big Government/Taxes – 08/27/17 – IT – Interview with Ex-Congressman Ron Paul, about several current issues, as well as about the need for government to follow the Constitution.

Terrorism/Women’s Rights – 08/27/17 – IT – Interview with Christina Douglass-Williams, Journalist and TV Producer, about efforts by moderate Muslims to condemn Jihad, and about the need for more women’s rights.

Discrimination/Consumerism – 08/27/17 – IT – Interview with Dr. Howard Kushner, Author of “On the Other Hand,” about the challenges some left-handers face with everyday life, and about the need for more left-handed products.

Discrimination/Education – 09/03/17 – IT – Interview with Todd Gaziano, Head of Washington Office, Pacific Legal Foundation, about the current state of affirmative action, and about the need for less discrimination against Asians.

Veterans/Unemployment – 09/03/17 – IT – Interview with Melissa Davies, President of Wise Ways Consulting, about her programs that aid vets getting back into society, and about things companies can do to keep employees.

Youth/Education – 09/03/17 – IT – Interview with Dr. Eileen Kennedy-Moore, Child Psychologist and Author, with some tips parents should use to help their kids get back into school successfully, and about the effect of social media on kids.

Health/Obesity – 09/10/17 – IT – Interview with Dr. Stephen Faraone, Prof. of Psychiatry at University of NY Upstate Medical University, about ADHD in adults and why it is not diagnosed as often as it should be, as well as about obesity and its effects on ADHD.

Education/Youth – 09/10/17 – IT – Interview with Dr. Kathy Hirsh-Pasek, Dis. Faculty Fellow at Temple Univ. and Senior Fellow at Brookings Institute, about her book that deals with how to make kids more brilliant, and about the influence that parents must make on their children to increase their success.

Youth/Obesity – 09/17/17 – IT – Interview with Ken Krieg, Health Author, about ways parents can avoid overindulging their kids, and about the growing obesity level in the United States.

Economy/Unemployment – 09/24/17 – IT – Interview with Jim Stuber, Founder of Made in America Again, about efforts to get American jobs back on track, and about consumer boycotts as a way to curb foreign job increases.
