## RADIO STATION KVNN-AM, VICTORIA, TEXAS QUARTERLY ISSUES/PROGRAMS LIST 2<sup>nd</sup> QUARTER - 2018

Listed below are some of the significant issues responded to by Radio Station KVNN-AM, along with the most significant programming treatment of those issues for the period April 1, 2018 to June 30, 2018. The listing is by no means exhaustive or all-inclusive. These issues were in part ascertained through discussions with service-providers and general interaction of station staff with the community, and staff knowledge of the community and area occurrences. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any particular priority.

The following issues were principal topics or themes within the station's weekly public affairs program, "Issues Today" (IT), which is broadcast on Sunday Mornings at 7:00am. Each program has a normal running time (or length) in the range of 29 to 30 minutes. Each program is usually in two or three parts, each dealing with separate topics and issues.

School Shootings/Youth - 04/01/18 - IT - Interview with Dr. Joshua Estrin, School Safety Expert, about ways schools can be safer, and about how communities have to coordinate efforts better.

Graffiti/Crime - 04/01/18 - IT - Interview with Timothy Kephart, Founder of Graffiti Tracker, about the growing problem of graffiti in communities, and about his app that helps to track graffiti criminals.

Eating Disorders/Health – 04/01/18 – IT – Interview with Dr. Alitta Kullman, Psych-therapist and Eating Disorder Specialist, about the symptoms of eating disorders, and about practical ways to fight the disorder.

Health/Small Business – 04/08/18 – IT – Interview with Joel Allenbaugh, Foundation for Government Accountability, about the new healthcare options that will soon be available to small businesses, and about possible ways individuals will be able to change plans as well.

Sexual Abuse/Women – 04/08/18 – IT – Interview with Carolin Hauser-Carson, Psychotherapist and Author, about how women can heal from sexual abuse and harassment, and about the need for better education on the subject.

Depression/Drug Abuse - 04/08/18 - IT - Interview with Rick Haltermann, Author of "Curriculum of the Soul", about the importance of

spiritual ideas in each life, and about the overuse of drugs in this country because of depression.

Gun Control/Terrorism - 04/15/18 - IT - Interview with Rusty Humphries, Major Podcaster and Columnist, about current issues, and also about his experiences in visiting Guantanamo.

Health/Depression - 04/15/18 - IT - Interview with Dr. Ken Redcross, Physician and Author, about the advantages of taking Vitamin D on a daily basis, and about how to have better health habits.

Stress/Communication – 04/15/18 – IT – Interview with Michael Godfrey, Author of "Put Stress To Work", about how to make stress a positive thing, and about how to improve communication.

Airline Safety/Consumerism - 04/22/18 - IT - Interview with Gary Kennedy, Former General Counsel of American Airlines and Author, about airline service problems and how social media has affected them, and about the new bumping rules.

Economy/Rent Control - 04/22/18 - IT - Interview with Kathy Fettke, Co-CEO of Real Wealth Network, about the future real estate market, and about how proposed rent control laws will affect the market.

Health/Women - 04/22/18 - IT - Interview with Dr. John West, Breast Cancer Expert, about treatment options for those with breast cancer, and about prevention.

Economy/Cyber Security – 04/29/18 – IT – Interview with Eric Tyson, Financial Expert and Author, with some financial tips for millennials, and about the need for more protection for online accounts from cyber hacking.

Health/Obesity – 04/29/18 – IT – Interview with Dr. John Poothill, Physician and Author, about the worsening problem of obesity and how it affects Diabetes, and about how to eat the right foods.

Youth/Social Media – 04/29/18 – IT – Interview with Mic Shannon, Marine Corps. Vet and Musician, about how to bring the country back together, and about the need for more dialogue on social media.

Environment/Recycling – 06/03/18 – IT – Interview with Dylan DeThomas, VP of Industry Collaboration, The Recycling Partnership, about the present and future of recycling in the U.S., and about the positive effects on the environment.

Consumerism/Crime - 06/03/18 - IT - Interview with Gordon Newton, President of Newton Group Transfers, with some tips on how consumers can get rid of their timeshares, and about growing fraud in the industry.
