RADIO STATION KVNN-AM, VICTORIA, TEXAS QUARTERLY ISSUES/PROGRAMS LIST 2nd OUARTER - 2017

Listed below are some of the significant issues responded to by Radio Station KVNN-AM, along with the most significant programming treatment of those issues for the period April 1, 2017 to June 30, 2017. The listing is by no means exhaustive or all-inclusive. These issues were in part ascertained through discussions with service-providers and general interaction of station staff with the community, and staff knowledge of the community and area occurrences. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any particular priority.

The following issues were principal topics or themes within the station's weekly public affairs program, "Issues Today" (IT), which is broadcast on Sunday Mornings at 7:00am. Each program has a normal running time (or length) in the range of 29 to 30 minutes. Each program is usually in two or three parts, each dealing with separate topics and issues.

Health/Big Government – 04/02/17 – IT – Interview with Dr. Robert Marx, Professor of Surgery, Univ. of Miami's Miller School of Medicine, about some prescriptions that are deadly, and about how the government needs to do more to study drugs.

Education/Youth - 04/02/17 - IT - Interview with Adrian Ridner, College Tuition Expert, about how families can save money on college tuition, and about how corporations are aiding students with tuition.

Youth/Education - 04/02/17 - IT - Interview with Rich Schramm, Inventor of I Got This App, about the purpose of the app, to aid those with ADD, and about the positive results that are taking place with users.

Nuclear Power/Environment – 04/09/17 – IT – Interview with Dr. Michael Brannigan, Japan Nuclear Disaster Expert, about the cleap-up efforts going on in Japan, and about possible long-term effects on the United States.

Racism/Economic Inequality – 04/09/17 – IT – Interview with Taimak, Actor and Author, about racism in America, and about financial inequality.

Women/Economy – 04/09/17 – IT – Interview with Cheryl Fields, Holistic Health Expert, with some tips for women on how they can be more healthy, and about their gains in the business world.

Immigration/Unemployment - 04/16/17 - IT - Interview with Gregg Roman, Director of Middle East Forum, about the travel ban and the effects it will have on the American Economy, and about immigration reform.

Economy/Taxes - 04/16/17 - IT - Interview with Kathy Fettke, Co-CEO and Co-Founder of Real Wealth Network, about interest rate hikes, and about the possible over-sale of the stock market.

National Healthcare/Consumerism – 04/30/17 – IT – Interview with Dr. Jane Orient, Ex. Director of Assn. of American Physicians and Surgeons, about the defeat of national healthcare reform, and about the need for more independent health initiatives.

Youth/Education - 05/28/17 - IT - Interview with Denise Lorenz, Education Author, about the need for kids to stay mentally engaged during the summer months, and about the importance of educational games.
