3<sup>rd</sup> QUARTER - 2019

Listed below are some of the significant issues responded to by Radio Station KVNN-AM, along with the most significant programming treatment of those issues for the period July 1, 2019 to September 30, 2019. The listing is by no means exhaustive or all-inclusive. These issues were in part ascertained through discussions with service-providers and general interaction of station staff with the community, and staff knowledge of the community and area occurrences. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any particular priority.

The following issues were principal topics or themes within the station's weekly public affairs program, "Issues Today" (IT), which is broadcast on Sunday Mornings at 7:00am. Each program has a normal running time (or length) in the range of 29 to 30 minutes. Each program is usually in two or three parts, each dealing with separate topics and issues.

Prison Reform/Crime - 07/07/19 - IT - Interview with Shane Bauer, Investigative Reporter and Author, about the private prison system in America, and about why conditions are so bad in some prisons.

Socialism/Education - 07/07/19 - IT - Interview with Ken Kline, Researcher and Filmmaker, about the costs of sanctuary cities, and about international efforts to spread socialism.

Environment/Climate Change - 07/07/19 - IT - Interview with Dr. Paul Zeitz, Senior Policy Advisor at Healthy Climate Alliance, about the efforts necessary to fight climate change, and about the need for growth in the nuclear power industry.

Suicide/Youth - 07/14/19 - IT - Interview with Kevin Hines, Suicide Prevention Expert, about his story of attempted suicide, and about how people can help those who may be thinking about harming themselves.

Disaster Preparedness/Consumerism - 07/14/19 - IT - Interview with Joe Martyak, Director of Communications, Consumer Product Safety Commission, with some tips for those who might be the victims of tropical storms, and about the need for more homes to be equipped with CO2 detectors.

Health/Education - 07/14/19 - IT - Interview with Cliff Numark, Senior Vice President of Red Cross Biomedical Services, about the need for more blood donations throughout the country, and about the rules for donating.

Health/Seniors - 07/21/19 - IT - Interview with Scott Page, CEO of Lifeguide Cancer Treatment Partners, about the financial burdens that most cancer patients face, and about extra obstacles for seniors.

Youth/Health - 07/21/19 - IT - Interview with Dr. Lynn Lipskis, Sleep Expert and Author, with some nutrition tips for those seeking to have better sleep, and about new treatments for sleep apnea.

Economy/Communication - 07/21/19 - IT - Interview with Kathleen Marquard, Vice President of American Policy Center, about challenges facing the beef industry, and about the growing vegan movement.

Communication/Stress - 07/28/19 - IT - Interview with Jim Haggan, Author and President of Haggan and Associates, about the divide that exists in the country, and about ways to stop the polarization.

Consumerism/Economy - 07/28/19 - IT - Interview with Gui Costin, Marketing Expert, about ways to market to the millennial generation, and about how Youtube is one of the most important marketing systems.

Stress/Communication - 07/28/19 - IT - Interview with Dr. Dean Aslinia, Department of Counseling Chair, University of Phoenix, about why vacations are important, and about how to make the most of the time off.

Economy/Consumerism - 08/04/19 - IT - Interview with Myra Nourmand, Principle of Nourmand and Associates, about the real estate market, and about the need for better consumer education.

Health/Consumerism - 08/04/19 - IT - Interview with Jared Turner, Lifestyle Expert and Healthy Living Advocate, about the growing essential oils industry, and about alternative health issues.

Sexual Abuse/Women - 09/01/19 - IT - Interview with Mannette Morgan, Certified Life Coach, about the growing MeToo Movement, and about how women can find their voice.

Crime/Health - 09/01/19 - IT - Interview with Alex Zlatin, CEO of Maxim Software Systems, about the growing problem of medical record theft, and about ways people can better protect their records.

Taxes/Consumerism - 09/01/19 - IT - Interview with Mark Steber, Chief Tax Officer of Jackson-Hewitt, with advice for those who are late in paying taxes, and about some scams that are taking place regarding tax advice.
