QUARTERLY ISSUES/PROGRAMS LIST
4th QUARTER - 2017

Listed below are some of the significant issues responded to by Radio Station KVNN-AM, along with the most significant programming treatment of those issues for the period October 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017. The listing is by no means exhaustive or all-inclusive. These issues were in part ascertained through discussions with service-providers and general interaction of station staff with the community, and staff knowledge of the community and area occurrences. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any particular priority.

The following issues were principal topics or themes within the station's weekly public affairs program, "Issues Today" (IT), which is broadcast on Sunday Mornings at 7:00am. Each program has a normal running time (or length) in the range of 29 to 30 minutes. Each program is usually in two or three parts, each dealing with separate topics and issues.

Crime/Bail System - 10/01/17 - IT - Interview with Eric Siddall, L.A. Deputy District Attorney, about efforts to change the bail system, and about why bail for most accused criminals is still necessary.

Health/Government - 10/01/17 - IT - Interview with Karen Howard, Executive Director of the Organic and Natural Health Assn., about efforts to keep the public informed about companies who have high standards regarding natural health products, and about government regulation.

Education/Parenting - 10/01/17 - IT - Interview with Brad and Greta Zude, Creators of My Baby Can Sleep Program, with some tips on how parents can get their newborn babies to sleep better, as well as some other parenting suggestions.

Big Government/Whistleblowers - 10/08/17 - IT - Interview with Martha Deutscher, Researcher and Author, about the growing controversy of security clearances, and about the need for more regulation to avoid abuses.

Women/Economy - 10/08/17 - IT - Interview with Dr. Robyn Deluca, Research Assistant Professor at Stony Brook University, about her book "The Hormone Myth," and about the need for better information for women.

Disabled/Consumerism - 10/08/17 - IT - Interview with Mariam Pare and Alana Tillman, Members of Mouth and Foot Painting Artists, about the

work they do painting with only the mouth and feet, and about their Christmas card program.

Environment/Recycling - 10/15/17 - IT - Interview with Daphna Nissenbaum, CEO and Co-Founder of TIPA, about new plastics that have been developed that are totally recyclable, and about how that will affect the economy.

Youth/Parenting - 10/15/17 - IT - Interview with Dr. Jeffrey Rubin, Author of "The Art of Flourishing," about the bad effects of some sports on children, and about how sports affects parenting.

Youth/Parenting - 10/15/17 - IT - Interview with Lorrie Walker, Safety Expert, about how parents can make their kids safer in car seats, and about those who use non-approved methods to fix car seats.

Education/Youth - 10/22/17 - IT - Interview with Mia Pritts, Head of Early Care and Education at wonderschool.com, with some tips on how parents can select the right pre-school, and about central internet areas where parents can search.

Health/Obesity - 10/22/17 - IT - Interview with Dr. Christine Horner, Health Expert, about the relationship between obesity and cancer, and about some natural remedies to help with the problem.

Unemployment/Communication - 10/22/17 - IT - Interview with Carrie Williams, Employment Consultant and Author, about how employers can better communicate with their employees, and about the need for better work ethic in some age groups.

Terrorism/Women - 10/29/17 - IT - Interview with Shalva Hessel, Former Mossad Agent and Author, about how women are helping in the fight against terrorism, and about the challenges of a "spy" couple.

Seniors/Health - 10/29/17 - IT - Interview with Jae Oh, Medical Expert and Certified Financial Planner, with various tips to help those who are getting into Medicare, and about various deadlines that are needed to purchase plans.

Education/Communication – 11/26/17 – IT – Interview with Dr. Dudley Danoff, Prostate Cancer Expert, about new treatment options for those suffering from prostate cancer, and about the need for better communication between patient and doctor.
