QUARTERLY ISSUES/PROGRAMS LIST
1st QUARTER - 2021

Listed below are some of the significant issues responded to by Radio Station KVNN-AM, along with the most significant programming treatment of those issues for the period January 1, 2021 to March 31, 2021. The listing is by no means exhaustive or all-inclusive. These issues were in part ascertained through discussions with service-providers and general interaction of station staff with the community, and staff knowledge of the community and area occurrences. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any particular priority.

The following issues were principal topics or themes within the station's weekly public affairs program, "Issues Today" (IT), which is broadcast on Sunday Mornings at 7:00am. Each program has a normal running time (or length) in the range of 29 to 30 minutes. Each program is usually in two or three parts, each dealing with separate topics and issues.

Energy Conservation/Consumerism - 01/03/21 - IT - Interview with Steve Melink, Clean Energy Advocate and Author, about the merits of clean energy, particularly solar, and about the positive effects on the economy.

Health/Youth - 01/03/21 - IT - Interview with Dr. Arethusa Kirk, A Chief Medical Officer with United Healthcare, about the importance of baby health during the pandemic, and about the needs for vaccinations.

Consumerism/Communication - 01/03/21 - IT - Interview with Nik Miles, Host and Automobile Expert, about changes in the car buying process as a result of the pandemic, and about the need for even more communication to the public with apps.

Education/Coronavirus - 01/10/21 - IT - Interview with Ravi Hutseeing, Education Researcher, Public Speaker, about a new approach to education that teaches students to be more self-reliant, and about new ways to train teachers.

Youth/Activism - 01/10/21 - IT - Interview with Laura Pelligrini, Director and Producer, about her new documentary that is focused on youth activists, as well as some insight into the making of the video.

Consumerism/Culture - 01/10/21 - IT - Interview with Karina Lamerana, Home Organizer and Designer, with some tips on how to unclutter homes, and about some of the trends in furniture.

Immigration/Big Government - 01/17/21 - IT - Interview with Juan Riboldi, President of Ascent Advisor, about changes in the immigration system over the years, and about what changes might be made during the Biden Administration.

Cultural Arts/Health - 01/17/21 - IT - Interview with David Krehbiel, Dyslexia Expert and Author, about his life with Dyslexia even as he excelled as an orchestra musician, and about some of the symptoms.

Alcoholism/Health - 01/17/21 - IT - Interview with John Walker, Co-Founder of Non-Alcoholic Brewery, about Dry January, an event to help people get away from alcohol, and about their efforts to greatly expand the event.

Coronavirus/Education - 01/24/21 - IT - Interview with Dr. Dean Fanelli, Vaccine Researcher, about plans for mass vaccinations for the Coronavirus, and about the effectiveness of the shots.

Coronavirus/Bankruptcy - 01/24/21 - IT - Interview with Shawn Wright, Bankruptcy and Tax Attorney, about ways the public can get out from under holiday overspending, and about ways to stay out of bankruptcy.

Racism/Media Bias - 01/24/21 - IT - Interview with Tamara Payne, Malcolm X Researcher and Author, about the highlights of Malcolm X's life, and about the 30 years of research that she and her father did to write the book.

Free Speech/Big Government - 01/31/21 - IT - Interview with Ian Rosenberg, Legal Counsel for ABC News, about free speech in America, and about efforts to suppress expression by social media giants.

Consumerism/Artificial Intelligence - 01/31/21 - IT - Interview with Steve Greenberg, Author and TV Personality, about the highlights of new products at CES, and about the future of robots in society.
