RADIO STATION KVNN-AM, VICTORIA, TEXAS QUARTERLY ISSUES/PROGRAMS LIST 3rd QUARTER - 2016

Listed below are some of the significant issues responded to by Radio Station KVNN-AM, along with the most significant programming treatment of those issues for the period July 1, 2016 to September 30, 2016. The listing is by no means exhaustive or all-inclusive. These issues were in part ascertained through discussions with service-providers and general interaction of station staff with the community, and staff knowledge of the community and area occurrences. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any particular priority.

The following issues were principal topics or themes within the station's weekly public affairs program, "Issues Today" (IT), which is broadcast on Sunday Mornings at 7:00am. Each program has a normal running time (or length) in the range of 29 to 30 minutes. Each program is usually in two or three parts, each dealing with separate topics and issues.

Gun Control/Big Government – 07/03/16 – IT – Interview with Stephanie Soechtig, Producer of "Under the Gun", about her controversial documentary, and about efforts to get stricter gun control laws enacted.

Health/Stress - 07/03/16 - IT - Interview with Dr. Lillie Rosenthal, Pain Management Expert, about the growing use of powerful drugs for pain, and about more natural treatments for management.

Health/Big Government – 07/10/16 – IT – Interview with Peter Pitts, Co-Founder of Center for Medicine in the Public Interest, about the growing use of antibiotics and how it is affecting the treatment of some diseases, and about the need for more research into newer drugs.

Consumerism/Big Government – 07/10/16 – IT – Interview with Orianna Schwindt, TV Reporter for Int. Business Times, about the influence of Netflix and how it will affect the future of television, and about the financial aspects of live sports on television.
